There are several intersections with less busy streets, and a signalized crossing at Court Street. Benches are provided at intervals along the landscaped route.

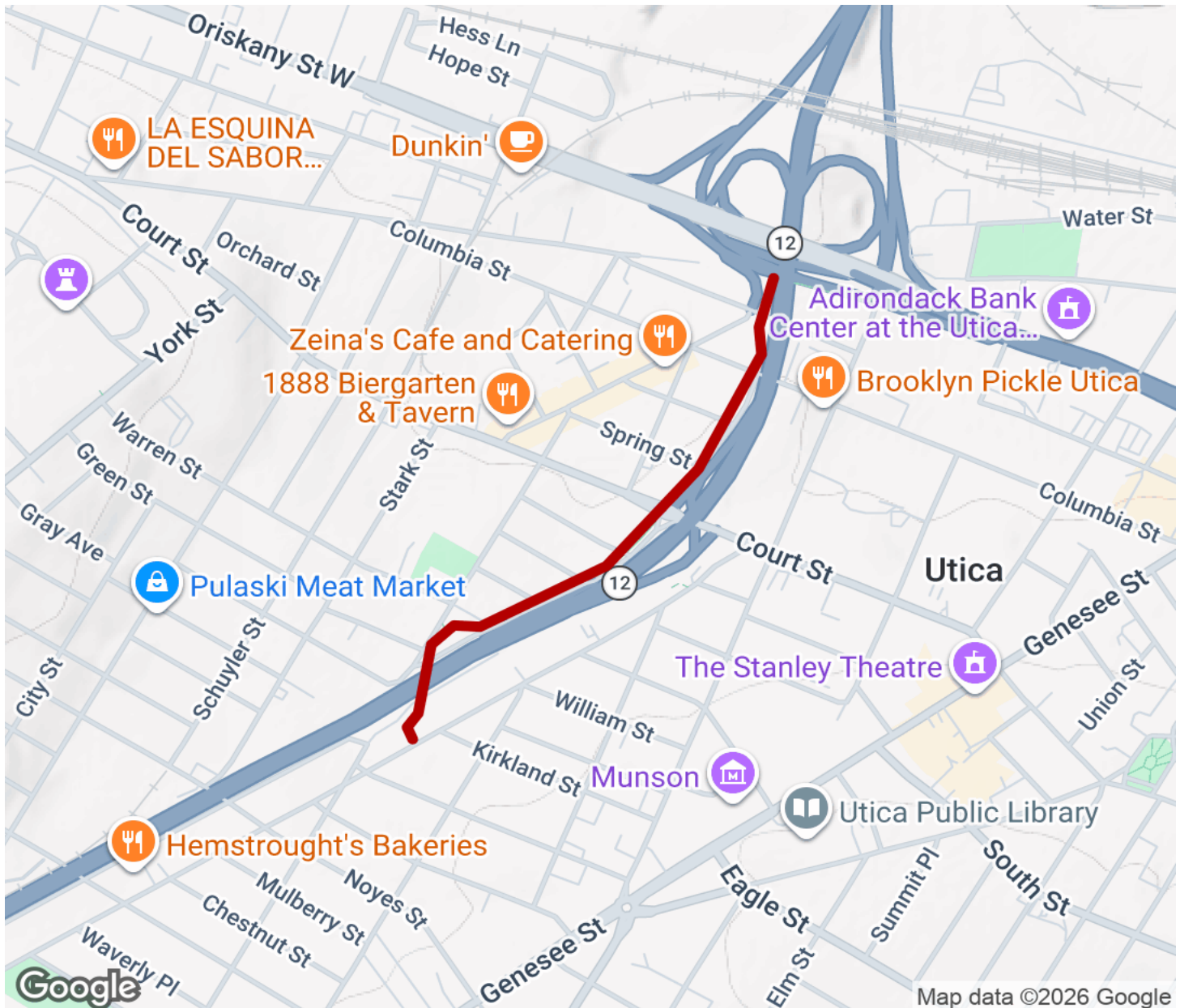
