About the Route

From its northern end by the intersection of FL-390/W 14th St & Georgia Ave, the rail-trail runs southeast through trees and scrub to its southern end on US Hwy 231.

The northern trailhead is named after the former Lynn Haven Commissioner Frances Wittkopf. The southern trailhead at Highway 231 is named after Ray Wishart, a retired Mosley High School educator.

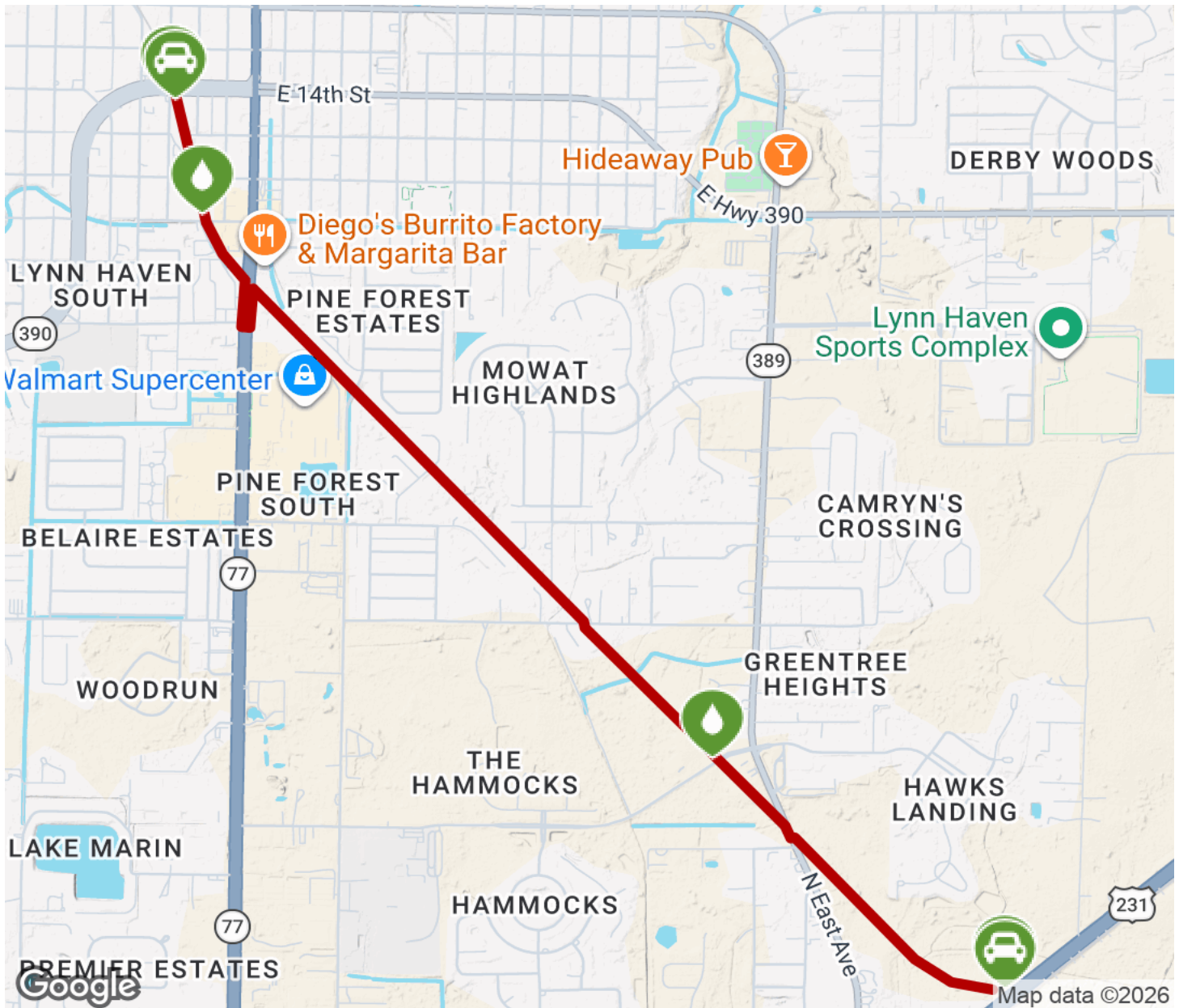
Parking & Trail Access
