This bicycle and pedestrian path parallels Lincoln Highway/US Highway 33 overpass, connecting Goshen High School to the north



This bicycle and pedestrian path parallels Lincoln Highway/ US Highway 33 overpass, connecting Goshen High School to the north end of downtown. At its southern end, the concrete sidepath connects to the [Monroe Street Trail](#), which travels east-west. Near the northern end it connects to a [bike-walk path](#) on Ninth Street. The US 33 Trail is part of the Goshen's Maple City Greenway system, a trail network of 30 miles and counting across the northern Indiana city.

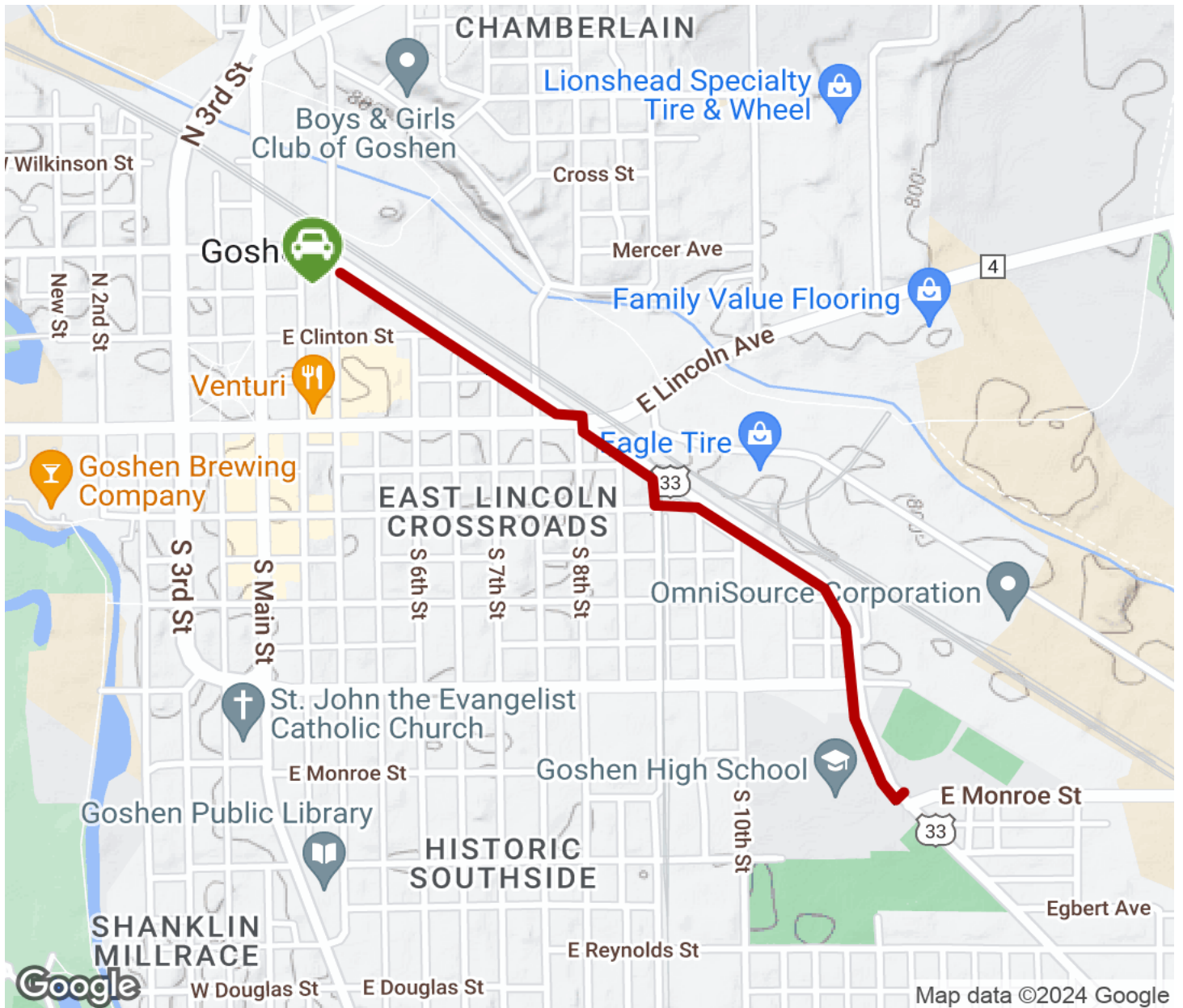
Parking & Trail Access
