The bridge is the first segment of the Green Crescent Trail, which is a proposed network of pedestrian and biking trails throughout the Clemson, Central, and Pendleton areas of South Carolina.

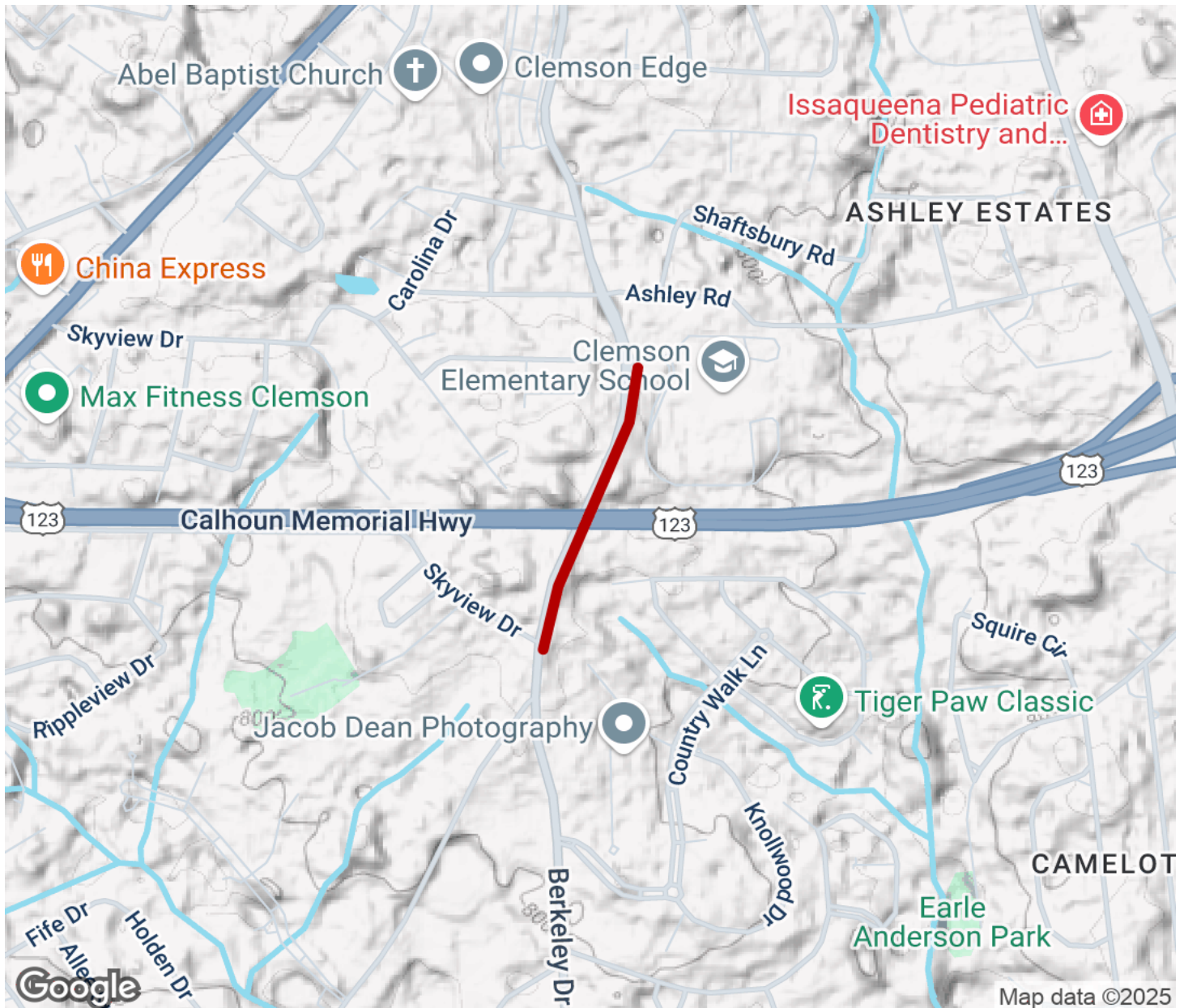
Parking & Trail Access
