Watertown Community Bike Path

Following along a former railroad right-of-way, this 8-foot-wide bike path runs alongside Arsenal St for 0.6 miles. Cyclists are protected from traffic by a physical barrier that separates the road and the bike path.

At its eastern end, the trail connects with the Watertown-Cambridge Greenway, which heads north to West Cambridge, Cambridge Highlands, the Fresh Pond Reservation, and the Fresh Pond Bikeway.

Near the trail's western endpoint, you can hop on the <u>Charles River Bike Path</u> (also referred to as the Charles River Greenway), which offers a paved route along the river to Boston and connections to neighboring towns. Follow the greenway east about 0.3 miles to enjoy the <u>Watertown Riverfront Park and Braille Trail</u> (147
