A separate path for biking and walking on the I-74 bridge over the Mississippi. There's an easy connection to the <u>Great River Trail</u> on the Illinois side and a poorly marked short road connection to the <u>Mississippi River Trail</u> on the Iowa side. There are great views of the river and at the high point there is a window in the pavement so you can look down at the river below.

The path is fully separated from traffic, 14-feet-wide and ADA accessible.


Parking & Trail Access
