Montezuma B&O Walking Bridge

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The Montezuma B&O Walking Bridge crosses the Wabash River, connecting Vermillion county and Parke county. Previously an abandoned B&O railroad bridge, the structure underwent a revitalization that included the removal of the old rails and the addition of a new concrete surface and wooden handrails. The new 850-foot-long pedestrian bridge stretches from Water St in Montezuma over the river to Hillsdale, where it meets a paved trail that continues as far as the CSX Rail.
