Following a former Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way through the City of Fullerton, this trail provides an alternative pedestrian/



Following a former Union Pacific Railroad right-of-way through the City of Fullerton, this trail provides an alternative pedestrian/bike route from Fullerton's transit station (bus, Amtrack, & Metrolink) to the nearby neighborhoods.

The 10-foot-wide paved path is well-lit and lined with trees. Public outdoor fitness equipment can be found along the route. The City has plans to eventually continue the trail along the Union Pacific right-of-way to Imperial Hwy.

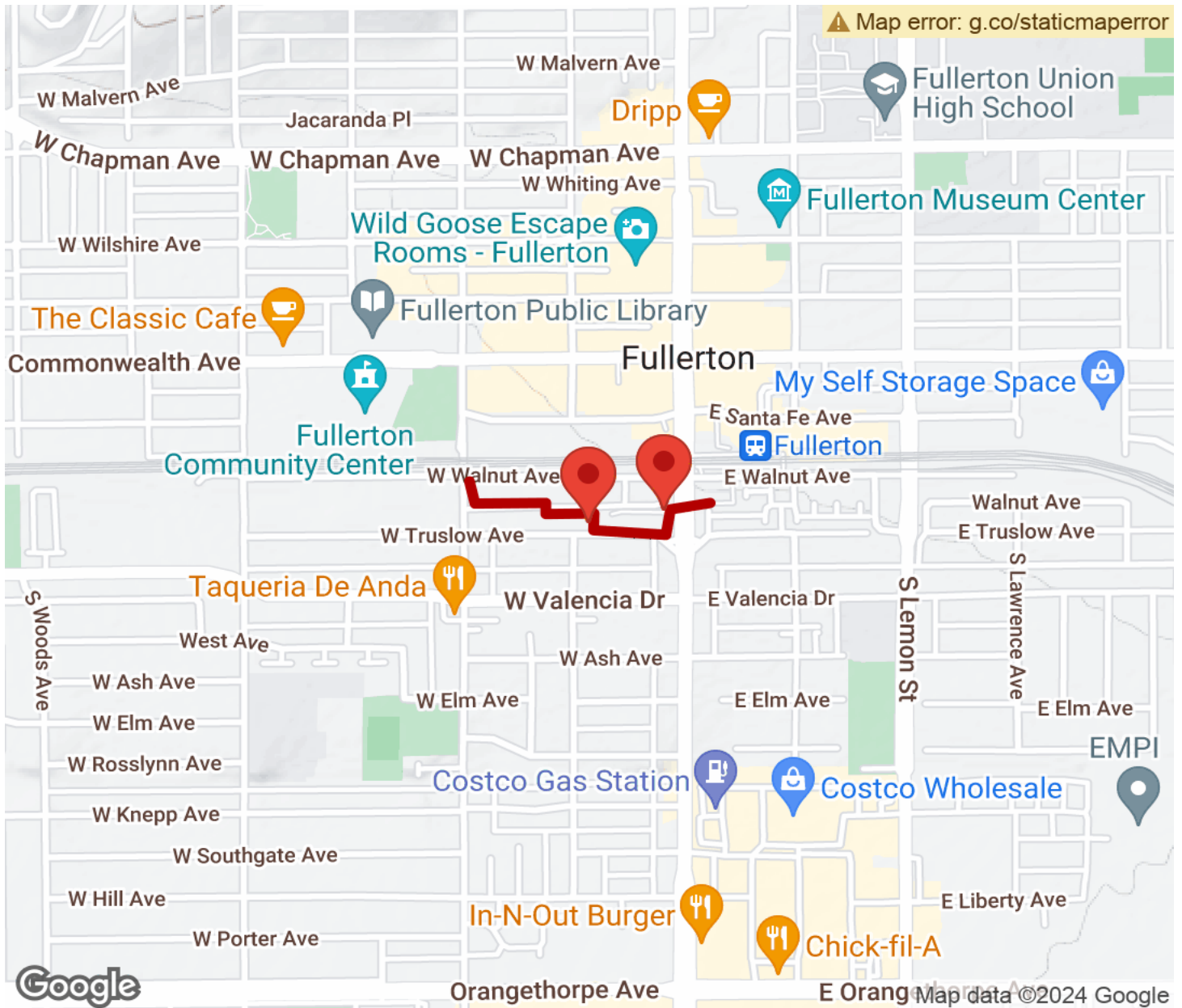
Parking & Trail Access
