*The Potanipo Rail Trail is composed of three segments across New Hampshire and Massachusetts. Running through the woods along*



The Potanipo Rail Trail is composed of three segments across New Hampshire and Massachusetts. Running through the woods along a former rail corridor, the trail parallels the Nissitissit River for a majority of its route.

[Two segments](#) of the rail-trail are in New Hampshire and the [third segment](#) crosses the border into Massachusetts as it heads south towards Pepperell.

Following a former rail corridor, this multi-use path is roughly 6ft wide with a stone-dust covered hardpacked surface and remains quite level throughout.


