The Fishing Creek Community Trail is a 1.3 mile public pathway from Flagg Chapel Baptist Church to the Oconee River Greenway.



The Fishing Creek Community Trail is a 1.3 mile public pathway from Flagg Chapel Baptist Church to the Oconee River Greenway. The trail is built with crushed gravel and woodchips. It runs from the west side of Memory Hill Cemetery southward to Fishing Creek, and then follows the north side of the creek beneath four city streets onto the Georgia Military College campus near the recreational ballfields. The trail follows the footprint of an abandoned rail line that was used to move clay and bricks in and out of the McMillan Brickworks in the 19th century.

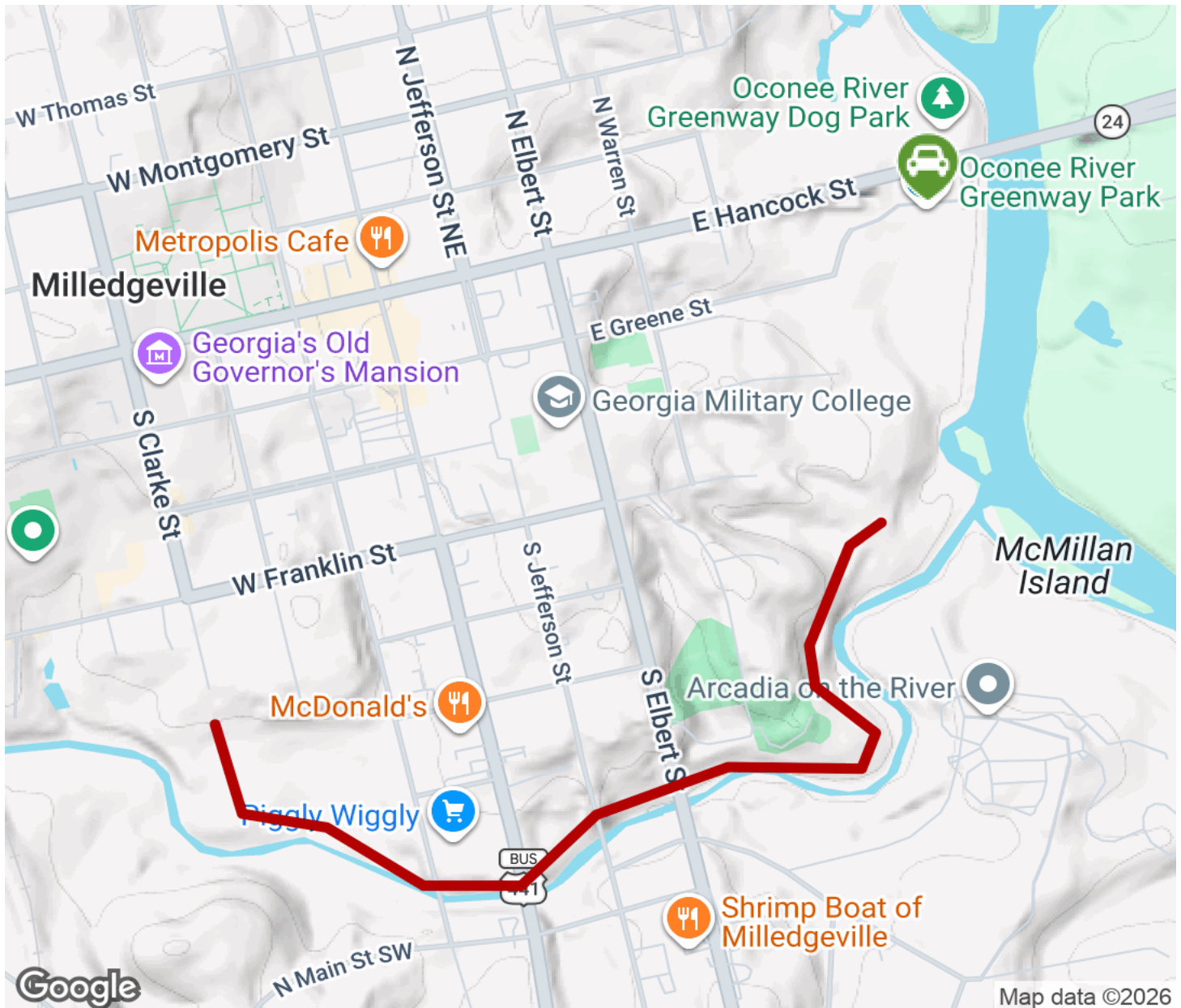
Parking & Trail Access
