Otto Armleder Memorial Park Ohio



Located in Cincinatti, Otto Armleder Memorial Park is 305 acres and home to a wide variety of recreational opportunities. The park



links with the Armleder-Lunken Connector Trail. Additional paths meander through the park.

Located in Cincinatti, Otto Armleder Memorial Park is 305 acres and home to a wide variety of recreational opportunities. The park has a playground, soccer fields, picnic areas and pavilion, a 10-acre dog park, a river overlook, and kayak/canoe access to the Little Miami River. The dog park has different areas for smaller and larger pups, a canine shower, and drinking fountains. The park is open from 6am to 10pm.

The trail has a paved 2-mile trail, the <u>Armleder Park Trail</u>, and a 1.0-mile paved trail, the <u>Armleder-Lunken</u>
<u>Connector Trail</u>, that links it to the 5.0-mile <u>Lunken</u>
<u>Airport Bike Path</u>, which loops around Cincinnati's municipal airport and connects with the <u>Ohio River Trail</u>. The southern endpoint of the 78-mile <u>Little Miami Scenic Trail</u> is located near the southern end of the park and
