In addition to open fields and wooded areas, the park has a community garden, playground, enclosed dog park, wading pool, ice rink, tennis court, basketball court, fishing pier, fountain, picnic area, restrooms, and drinking fountains.

A biking path runs through the park and wide, paved pedestrian paths connect the park's attractions. The [North Cedar Lake Regional Trail](#) runs north of the park.

The park is open from 6am to midnight.
