A paved multiuse pathway, the Clearfield Canal Trail follows the Davis Weber Canal in downtown Clearfield. Offering a pleasant canal-side opportunity for recreation, the trail also provides connections between various destinations ranging from schools and shopping to parks and museums.

The trail is currently composed of two separate sections. The shorter northern section runs south from M Street/E 650 N (UT-103) to E 300 N. The southern section picks up on E 200 S, just east of Veterans Memorial Highway (I-15) to University Park Boulevard/N 1200 W.

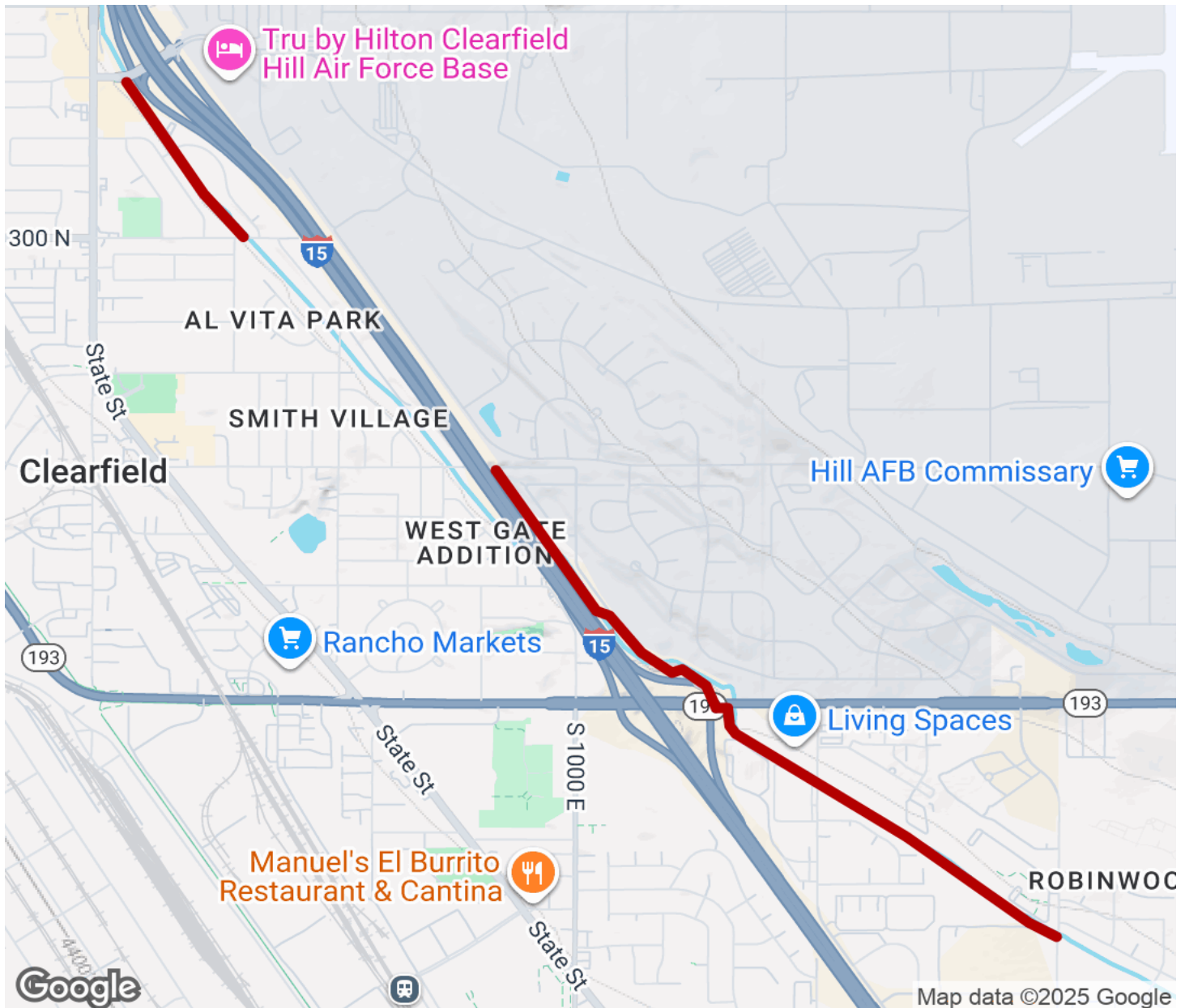
