The Midway Village Museum Loop is a 1.4-mile pathway around Guilford County Forest Preserve (6595 Guilford Rd, Rockford) and



The Midway Village Museum Loop is a 1.4-mile pathway around Guilford County Forest Preserve (6595 Guilford Rd, Rockford) and passes the Midway Village Museum (6799 Guilford Rd, Rockford). The trail connects to the [Perryville Path](#) by the intersection of Guilford Road & N Perryville Road and by the intersection of Garrett Lane & N Perryville Road. Near the southern end of the loop, the Keeling Trailhead Park includes a playground. The park is located off Shiloh Road just north of Garrett Lane.

Explore the Guilford County Forest Preserve via the trail loop or for a longer adventure, use a portion of the Perryville Path along N Perryville Road to create a larger loop.

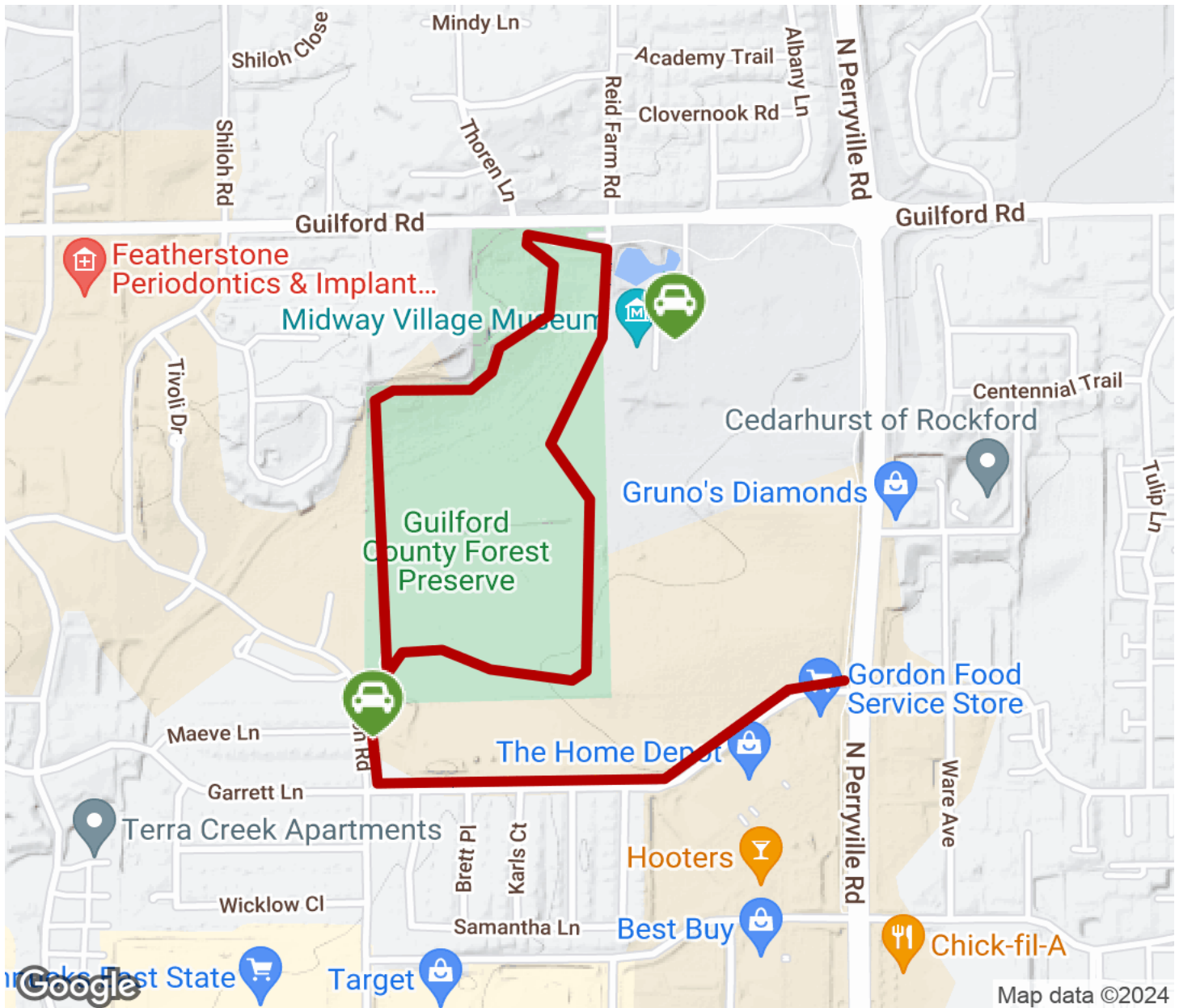
