Treadway Creek Trail Ohio



The Treadway Creek Trail is a paved, 8-foot-wide multiuse pathway that connects with the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail. The route



The Treadway Creek Trail is a paved, 8-foot-wide multiuse pathway that connects with the <u>Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail</u>. The route crosses several streams and there are six lookout areas with benches and interpretive signage.

From Harmody Park in Old Brooklyn, the trail meanders north through the woods to Crestline Avenue where it turns northeast and follows Jennings Road until it reaches Lower Harvard Avenue. The trail continues east on Lower Harvard Avenue until it connects with the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail in Cuyahoga Heights.
