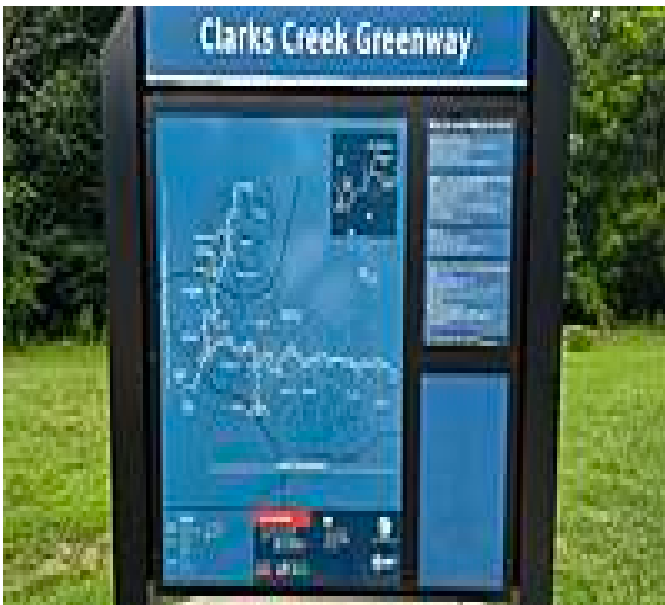

Parking & Trail Access

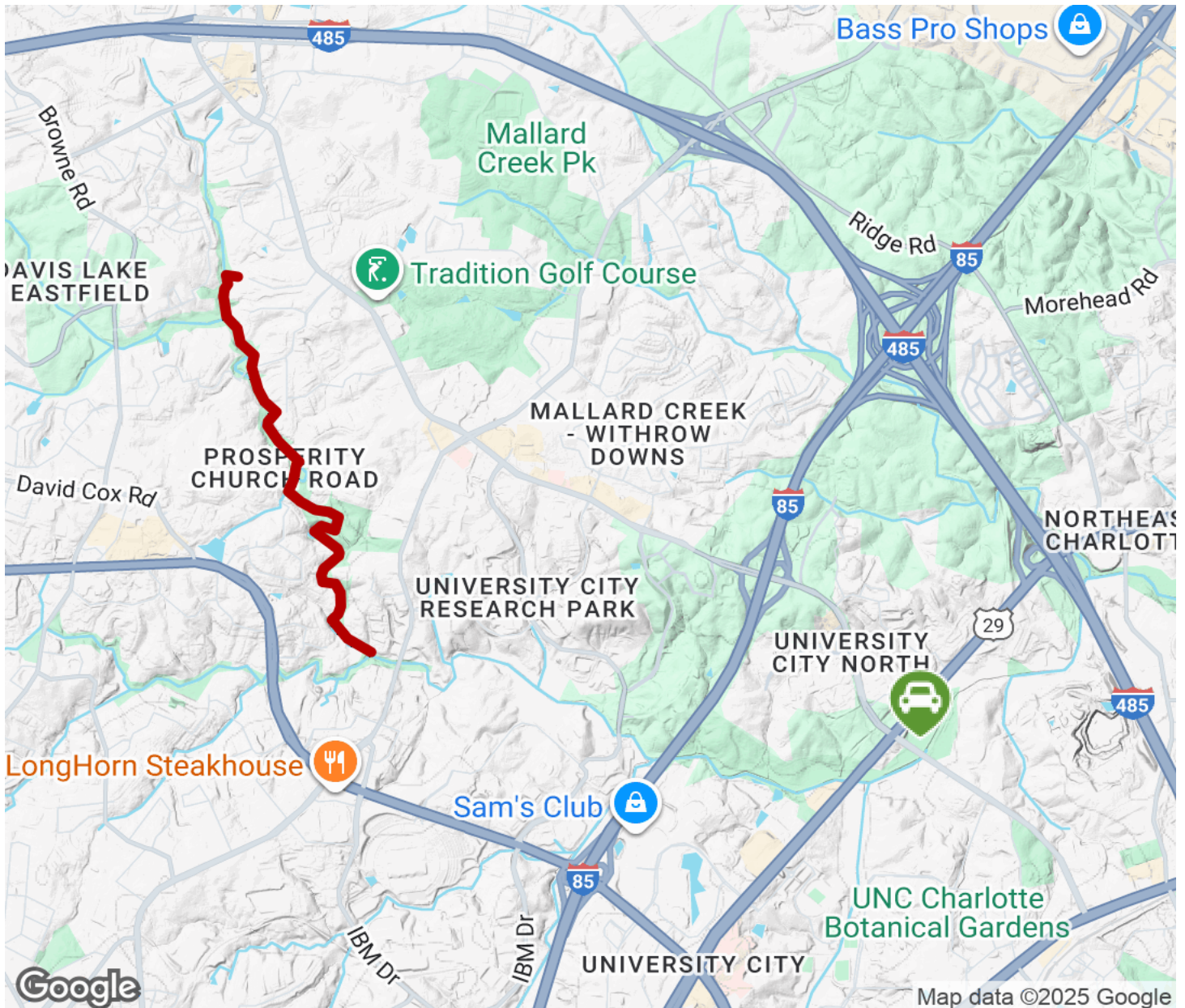
