Running between Mallard Creek Greenway and Rocky River Road, the Toby Creek Greenway provides an important connection with



Running between [Mallard Creek Greenway](#) and Rocky River Road, the Toby Creek Greenway provides an important connection with the University of North Carolina's Charlotte campus.

The paved, multiuse trail is smooth and 10-feet wide as it follows Toby Creek through the woods. From its southern end (805 Rocky River Rd W, Charlotte), the trail heads north for 2.7 miles to its connection with the Mallard Creek Greenway. The route crosses the creek via paved or boardwalk pedestrian bridges and there are short sections of boardwalk over the wetter areas. The boardwalk and bridge surfaces are still smooth and wide.

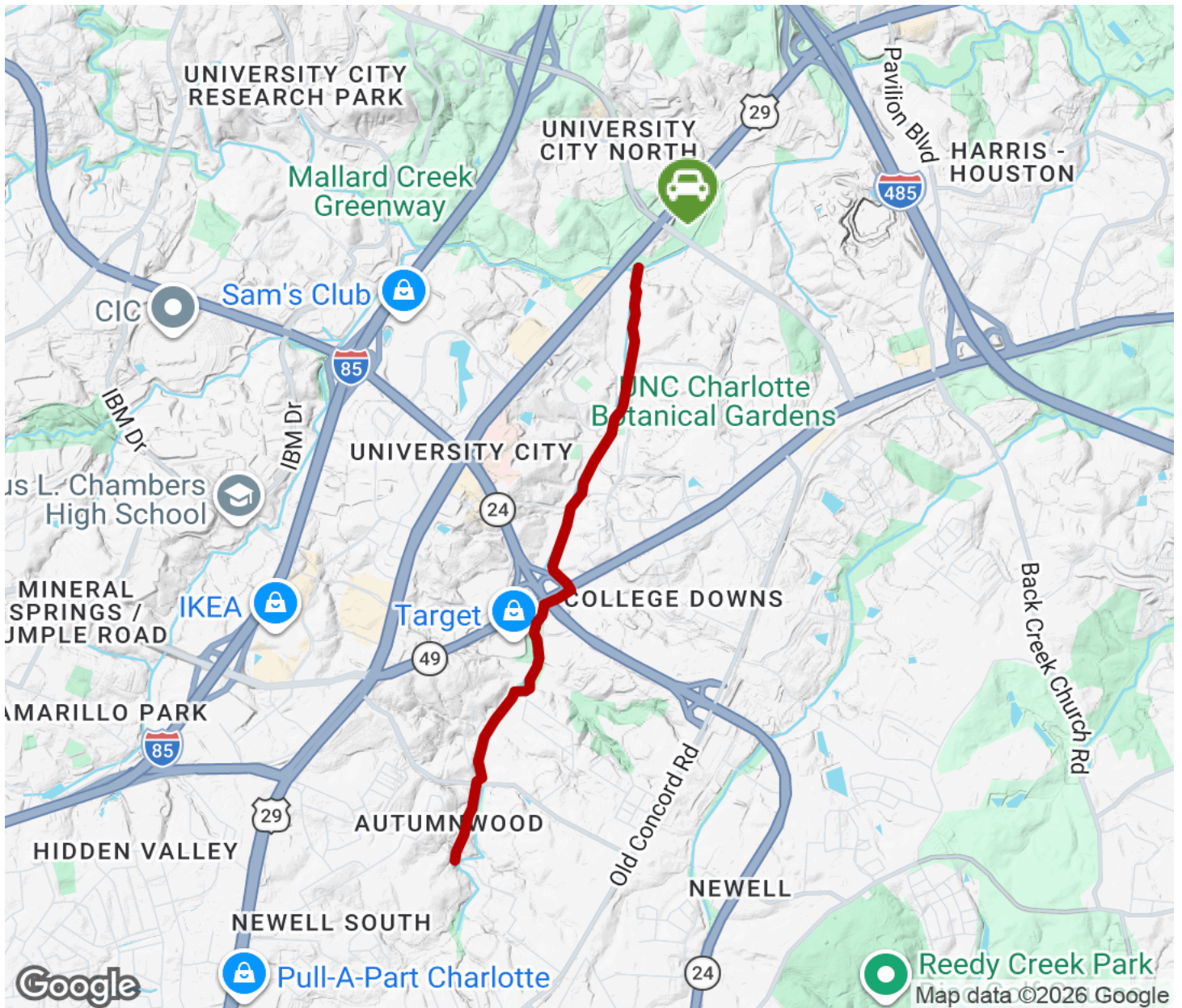
