The paved trail is smooth and wide, making it navigable for families with strollers and those using mobility devices.

From its connection with Confluence Trail, the trail winds northeast under the overpass to connect with the Cheshire Farm Trail on Lindbergh Drive.

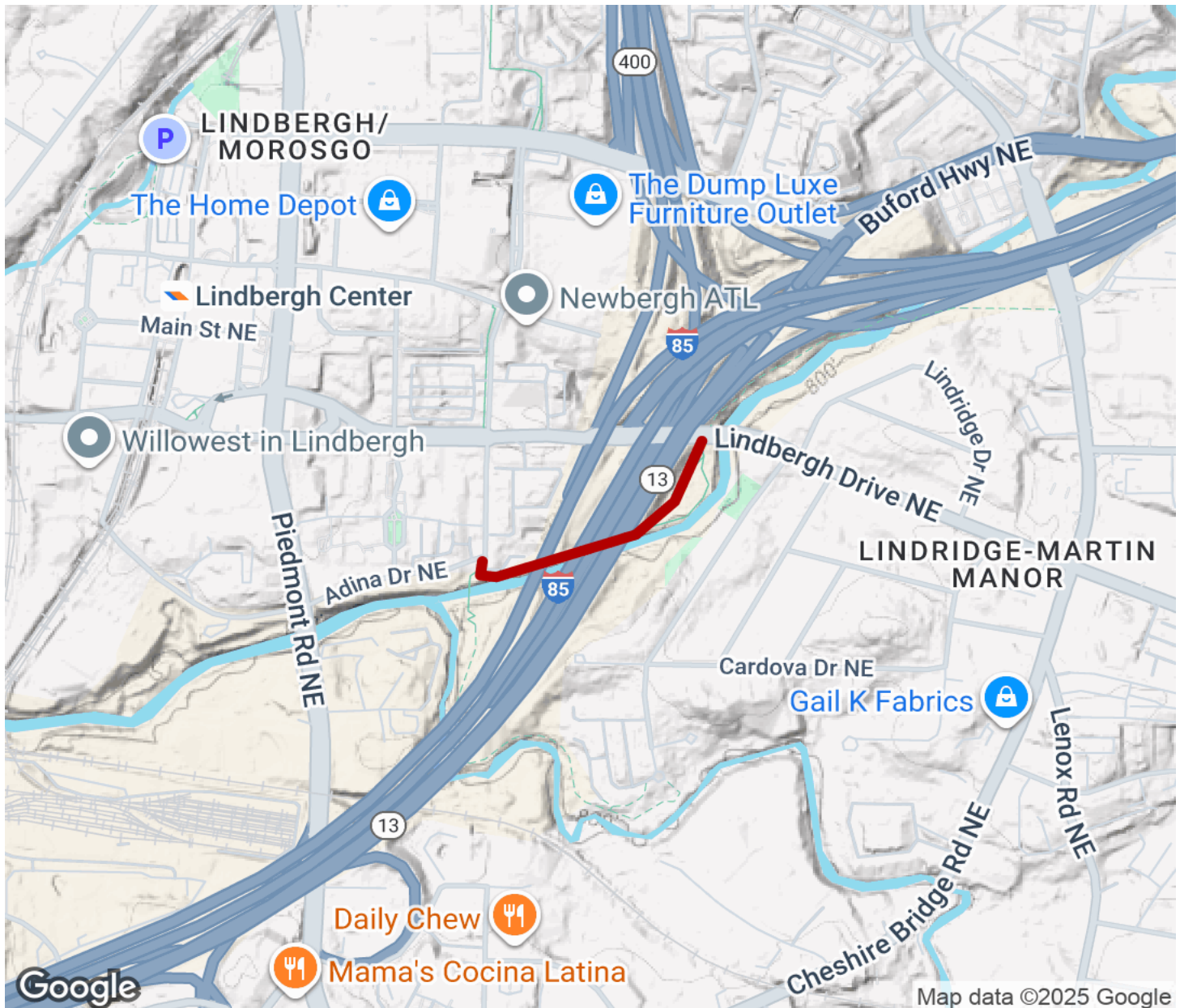
