The Ballenger creek Linear Trail is a 4.2 mile greenway in Frederick County Maryland. Constructed by both local developers and the county government, whose goal was to connect the community, the trail and short spur trails offer access to hotels, businesses, local parks, schools, and developments.

Starting at the Ballenger Creek Park, which has sports fields, a dog park, playground, community garden and parking, the trail then shares the sidewalk along Ballenger Creek Pike for nearly a mile, and passes by Tuscarora High School.

For nearly 2 miles, the trail runs uninterrupted along Ballenger Creek. there are several spur trails along this section that give trail users access to local subdivisions



and the Ballenger Creek Elementary School.

The final section of the trail continues along Ballenger Creek until reaching Buckeystown Pike, where there is a Home2 and Homewood Suites Hotel.


Parking & Trail Access
