The Como Lake Trail winds 1.8 miles around the lake. It is a one-way street that follows a counterclockwise direction.

From the lake loop, trail users can also take advantage of a nearly one-mile spur trail that heads south through through residential streets and over the railroad via. an impressive boardwalk bridge. This spur trail is ideal for local residents looking to access the lake loop and
