Deer Creek Bike Path

California

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The channelized Deer Creek that travels throughout Rancho Cucamonga and San Bernardino County provides water for the surrounding community, but the Deer Creek Bike Path provides recreation and outdoor access along the same route.

Starting off the trail's northern endpoint at Highland Ave, the Deer Creek Bike Path spends the entirety of its route following its namesake Deer Creek alongside its channel. The route includes a wide asphalt paved trail. The trail has a number of road crossings and trail users should be advised to keep aware of oncoming traffic.

1 mile south of the northern trail endpoint, the Deer Creek Bike Path meets the [Pacific Electric Inland Empire Trail](#), which travels 20 miles East-West.

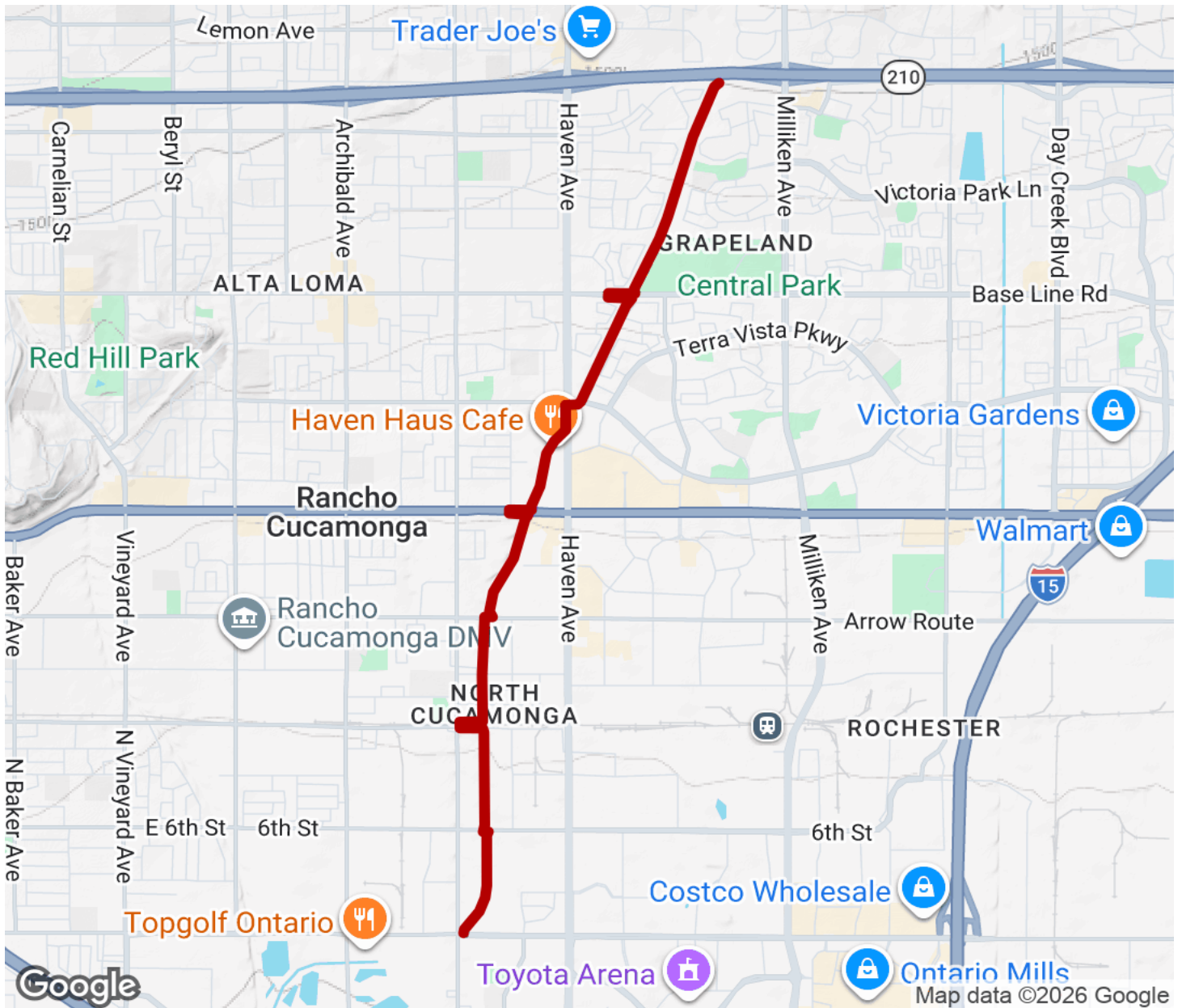
