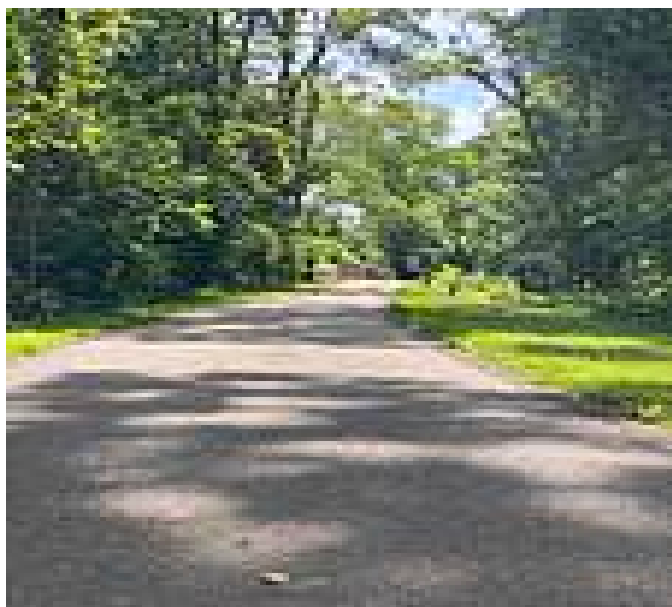

The Ogden Trail, or Elizabeth J Looney Trail, is a 3.3-mile trail that runs through Wilmington, OH reaching its western end at Ogden



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About the Route

This trail has four bridges that cross Todd's Fork as the creek winds back and forth across the trail corridor. The entire route, although paved, winds through scenic woodlands and farm fields, and has a distinctly rural feel to it.

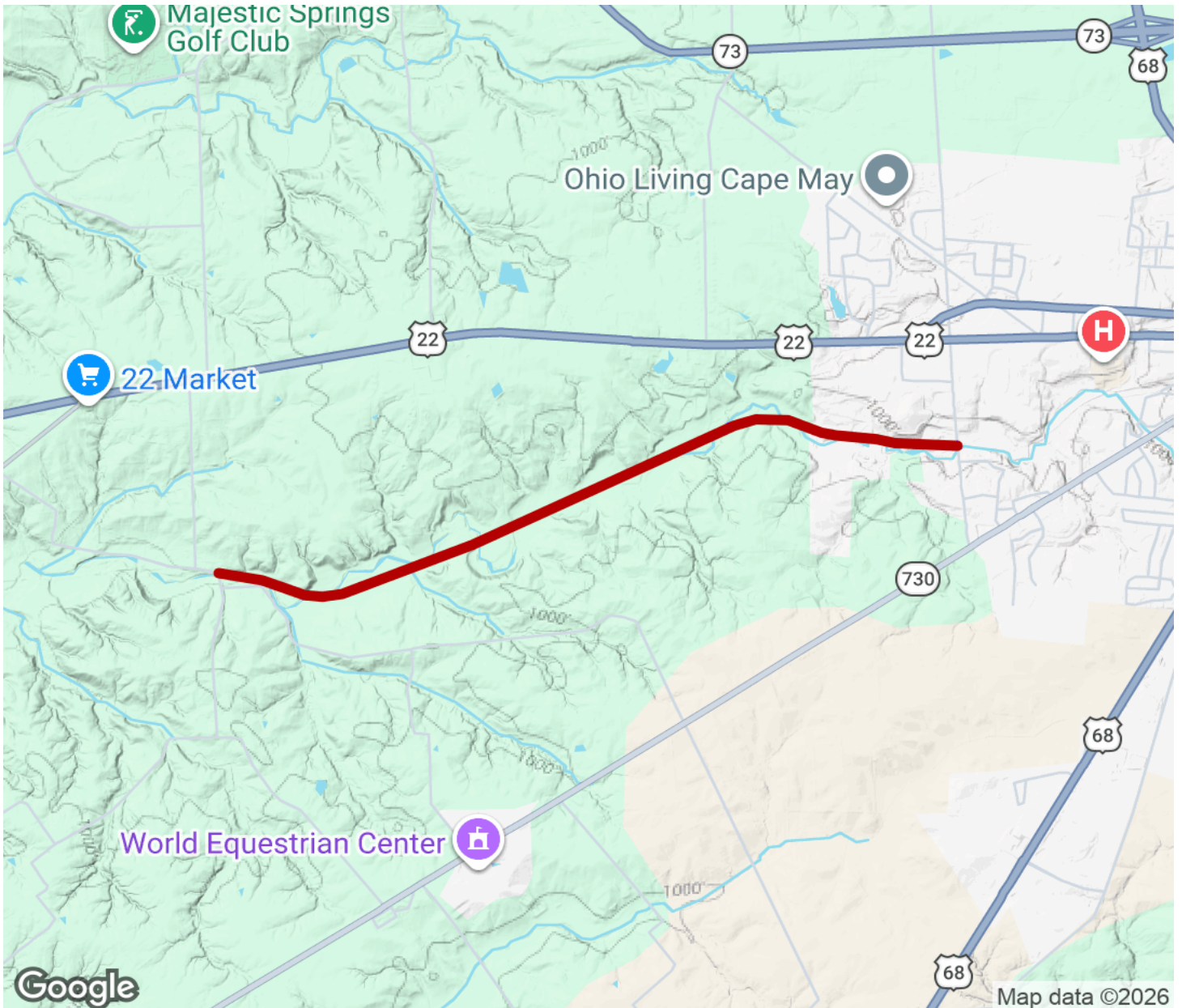
The Ogden/Elizabeth J. Looney Trail runs between S. Nelson Ave. (Wilmington) and Ogden Rd. (Wilmington).
