The Old Farragut Railroad Trail is a 3.4-mile pathway running between the City of Athol and Farragut State Park. About the Route

About the Route

Following a former railroad corridor, the trail has a rough surface of dirt, crushed stone, gravel, and grass. It is best suited to walking, mountain biking, horseback riding, cross-country skiing, and snowshoeing.

The trail runs fairly straight through a lightly wooded area. It crosses a couple streets, which provide access to the surrounding community.

The western end of the trail is near Athol's downtown,
