# Manchester Bike Trail

Michigan

*The Manchester Bike Trail is a 1.3-mile rail-trail that runs through the Village of Manchester, between the Village's western border*



gravel and grass surface.

Since there is currently no trail bridge over the River Raisin, a slight detour is required. Take sidewalks along N Washington Street and then East Main Street to cross the water.

Pick up the trail at Chi-Bro Park (209 Ann Arbor St). This section of the trail is paved. The rail-trail continues east through Manchester, crossing East Main Street and connecting residences, shops, public green spaces and a school in downtown Manchester. After crossing Hibbard Street and heading into a wooded area, the trail reaches its eastern end.

Dogs on leashes are allowed.

#### Connections

The plans for the trail include a connection with the Watkins Lake County Preserve and State Park trail.

The Manchester Bike Trail is a 1.3-mile rail-trail that runs through the Village of Manchester, between the Village's western border by Leonard Preserve and its eastern border, just east of Hibbard Street. Following a former railroad corridor, the trail has a mixed of paved asphalt and gravel.

Please note that there is currently a gap at the River Raisin that requires a detour using sidewalks to cross the river via the Main Street Bridge.

#### About the Route

From its western end by Leonard Preserve on North Union Street, the Manchester Bike Trail heads east along the southern edge of the preserve. This section has a

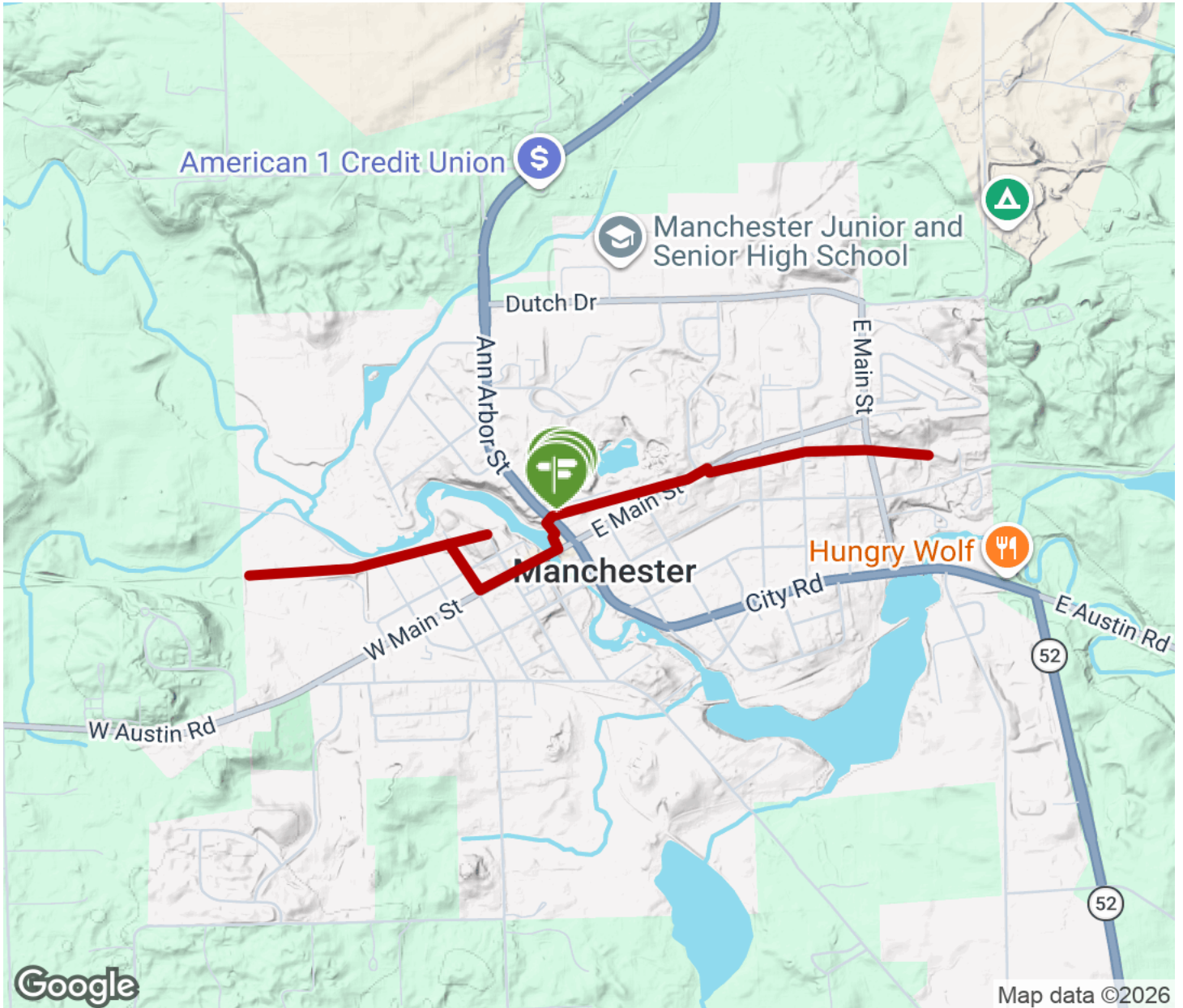
