About the Route

Connecting the new Skyline Trail, Zimmerman Park trail system, Alkali Creek Trail, and the Billings Heights trail system, the Skyway Trail provides incredible sunrises, sunsets, and views of incoming storms and aurora.

Cyclists and runners experience five miles of rolling hills and winding curves. Given the location of the trail, most users will complete down and back 10-mile excursions, or much longer loops that include Alkali Creek and Skyline Trails.

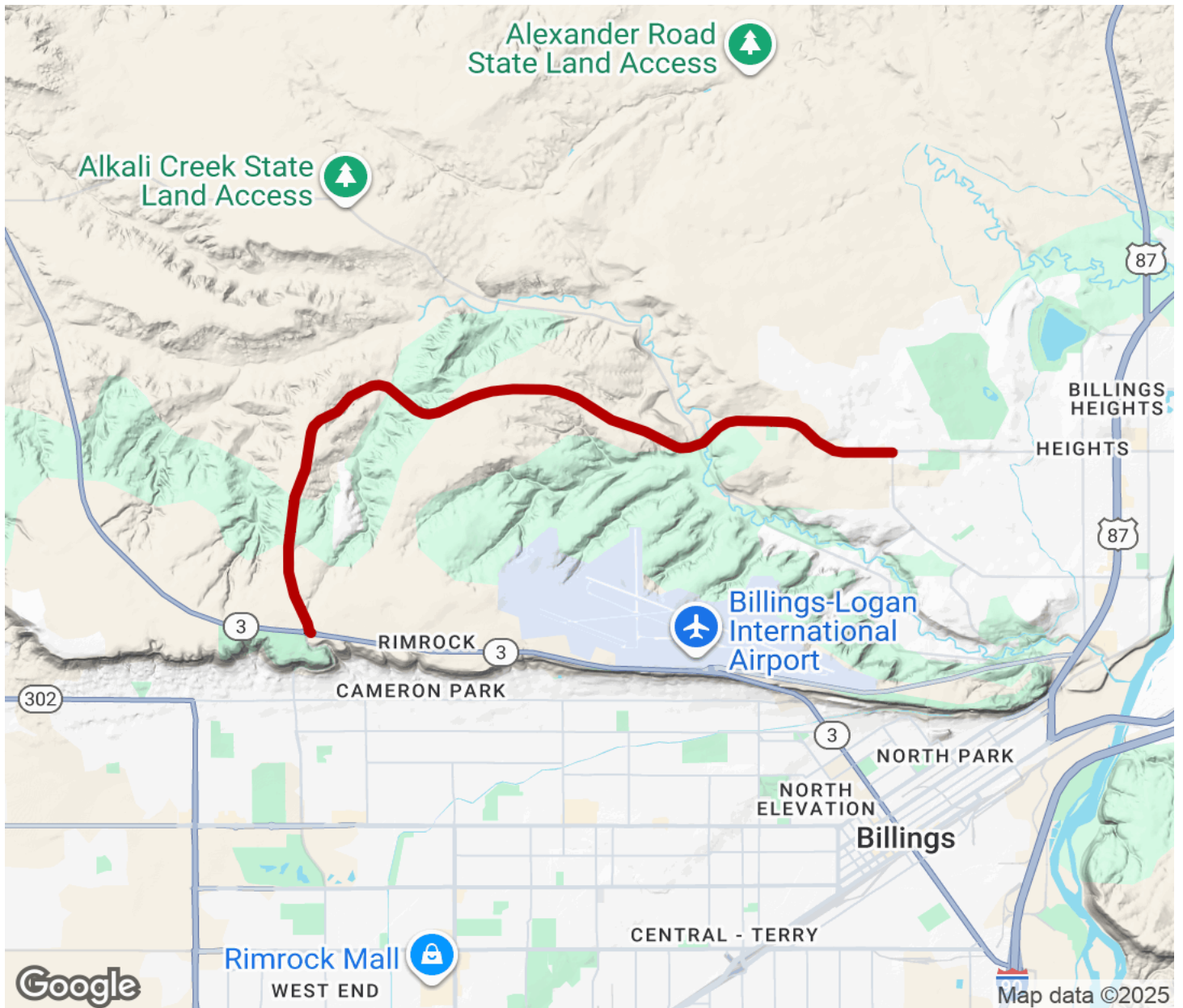
The Skyline Trail runs between Zimmerman Rd. (Billings) and Governors Blvd. (Billings).
