About the Route

The Valleybrook Pathway offers a short connection as it jogs between Rte 272 and Landis Valley Dr. in Lancaster. This path is best used for commuting and connecting to other longer trails in the Lancaster region.

Connections

At the Trail's midway, the Valleybrook Pathway connects to the <u>Heritage Trail</u>.

At the northern end of the trail, trail users can connect to the <u>Manheim Township Bikeway</u>.

At the southern end of the trail, the trail connects to the Worthington Pathway.
