About the Route

Unlike most rail trails, the Sluice Boxes State Park Trail is a hiking-only route. Along this 8.7-mile out-and-back trek, the trail passes by old cabins and mines. During low season, trail users can ford the river but be warned, the river is spring-fed and always cold.

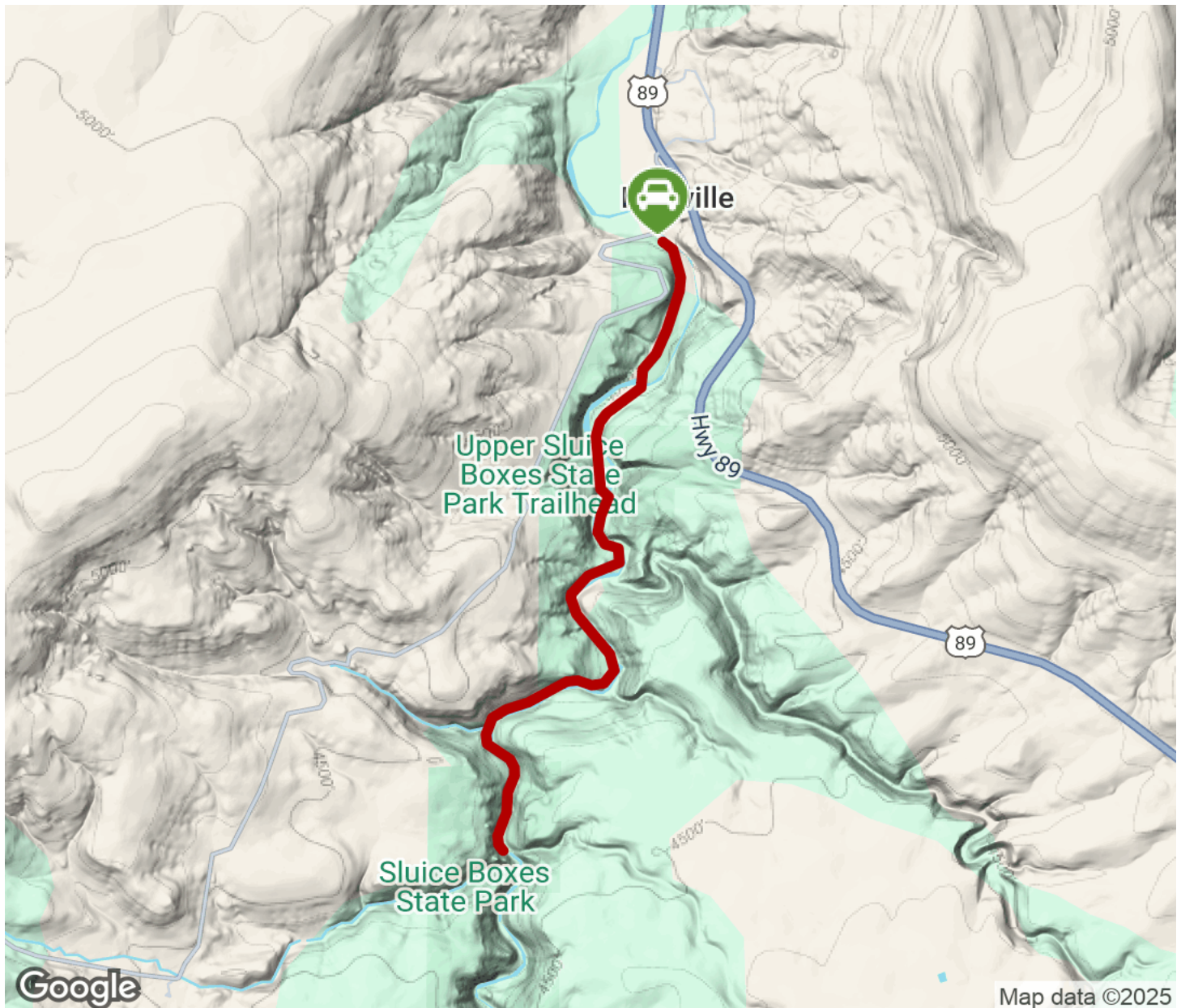
