About the Route

A rural route, the trail runs through forested landscapes at the north end of Michigan's lower peninsula. The Roger City Spur Trail runs entirely along the rail corridor, until reaching the North Eastern State Trail.

Connections

At the southern end of the trail, trail users can connect to the <u>North Eastern State Trail</u>.
