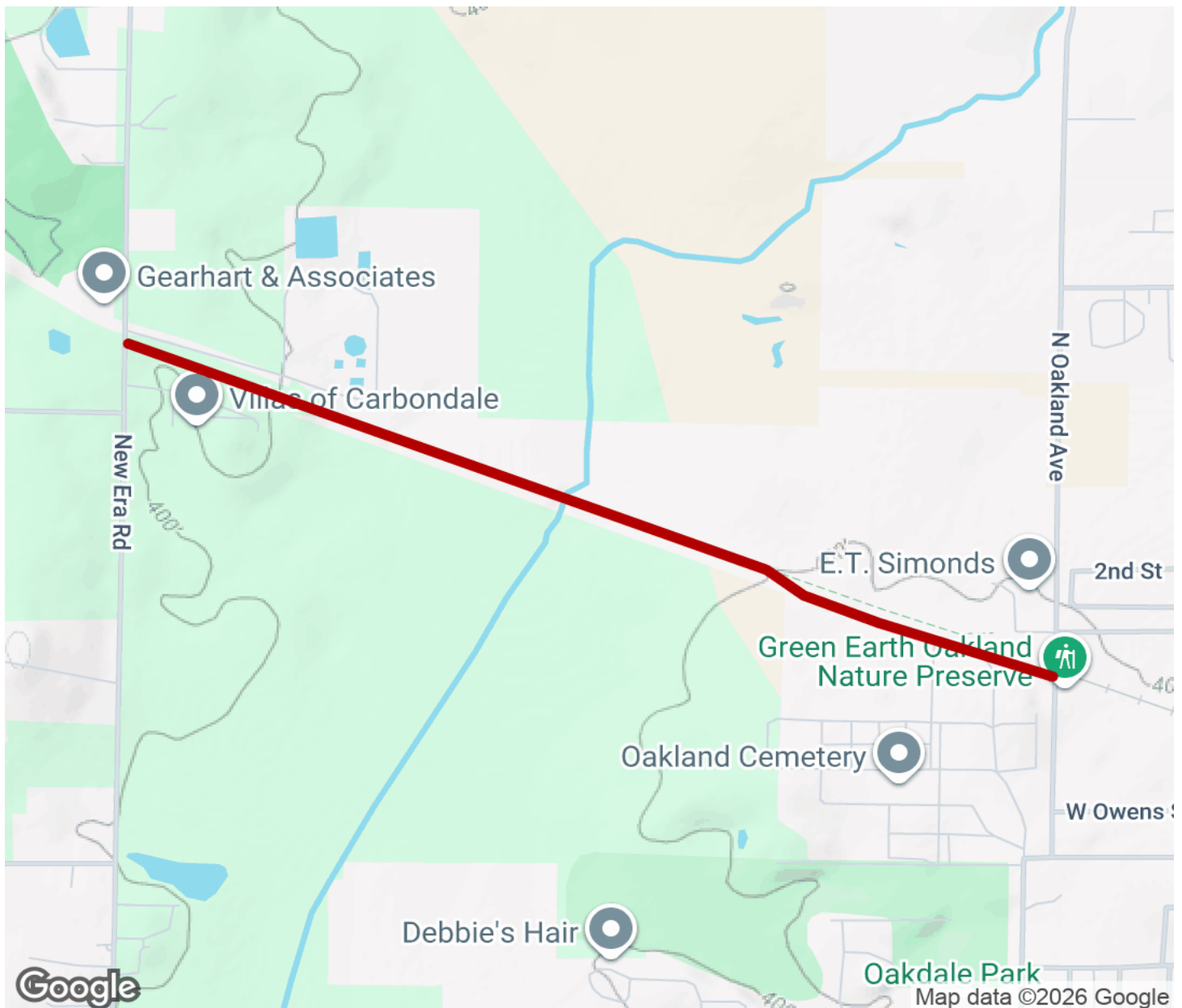
The Mud Line Trail runs between New Era Rd. and N Oakland Ave.
