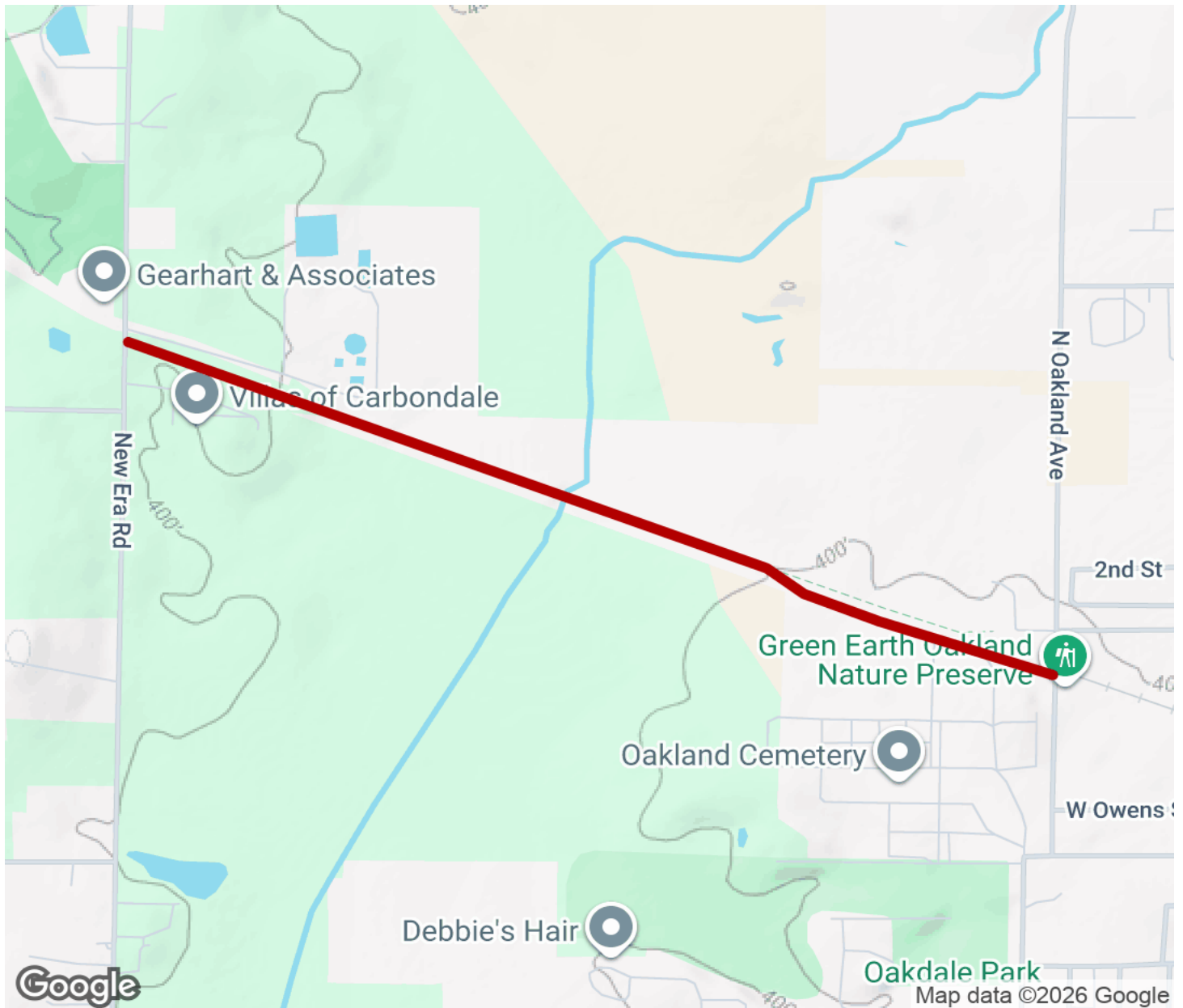
The Mud Line Trail runs between W Main St. and N Oakland Ave.
