There is no designated parking for the Link Trail, but there are numerous lots and street parking options throughout South Bend.



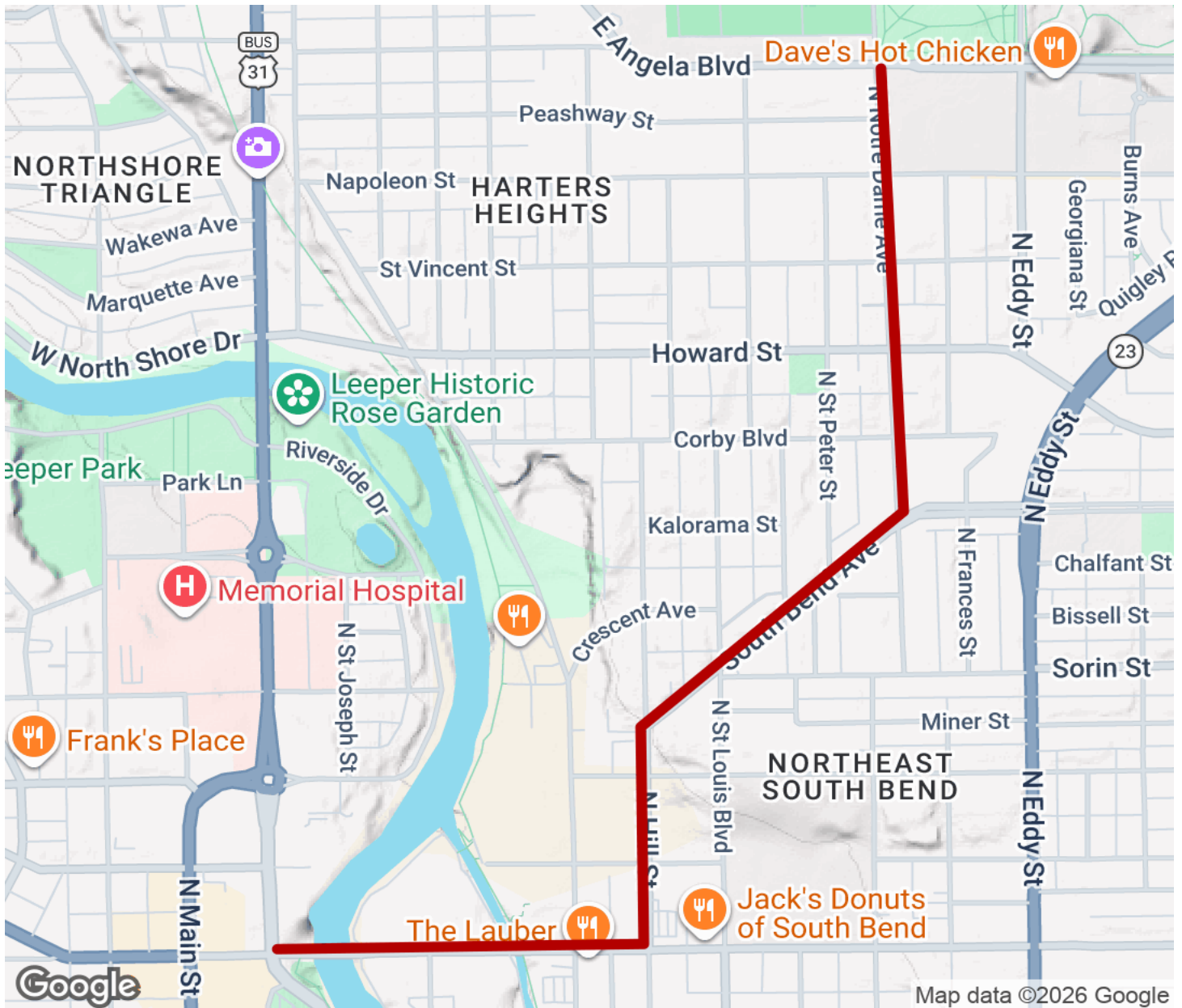
