Bolinas Ridge Trail

California

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The Bolinas Ridge Trail runs along the eastern edge of Port Reyes National Seashore. The 11-mile route is relatively flat as it winds along the hilltop, although best suited for mountain bikes because of the rough dirt surface.

Parallel to the northern end of the trail is the [Cross Marin Trail](#) which is accessible via a small unnamed spur.
