Coast Trail

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The trail connects to the Coast Campground at its southern end, a hike-in campground that also connects to nearby Laguna and Woodward Valley hiking trails. The campground offers access to a few amenities like water and restrooms, but is relatively rustic. Its premier feature is its access to undisturbed beachfront property, just steps from the campground.

The Coast Trail continues south past the campground, but is only open to hiking after that point.
