Mendenhall River Trail

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The Mendenhall River Trail, also known as Kaxdigoowu Heen Dei, is a two-mile route in the Mendenhall Valley neighborhood of Juneau, Alaska. The Kaxdigoowu Heen Dei is a Tlingit name for going back clearwater trail. The trail is paved and provides excellent views of the surrounding mountains.
