At the southern end of the route, the trail skirts the South Campus of the University of Colorado Boulder and then heads north until it connects to the [Valmont Multi-Use Path](#) and the [Boulder Creek Path](#).

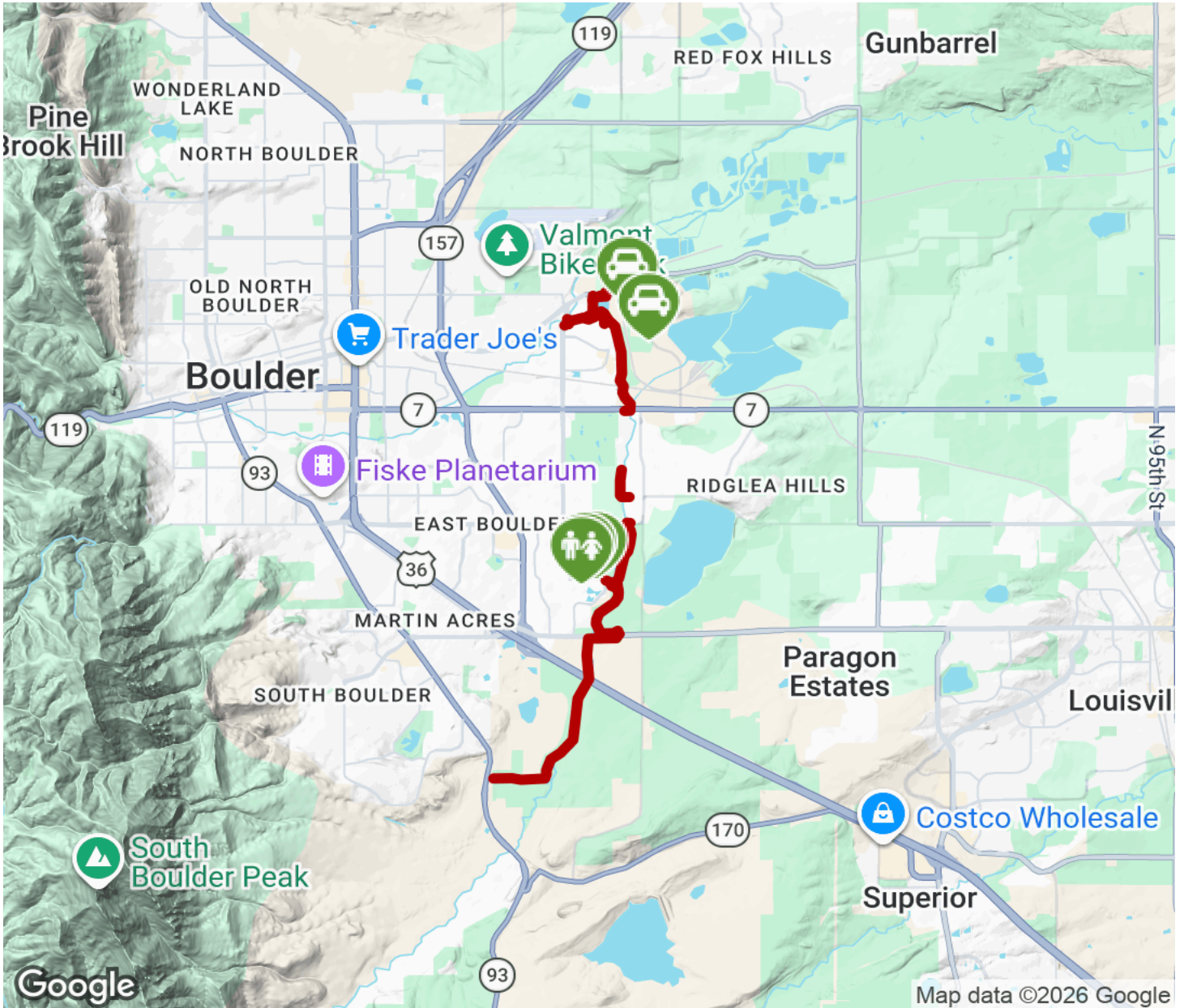
Parking & Trail Access
