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The 1.25-mile Chicago Riverwalk is a premier experience in downtown Chicago. The riverwalk includes pedestrian pathways, benches and landscaping that make it the perfect place to lounge as well as exercise. In addition, along the route there are statues and other historic monuments, riverfront bars and food kiosks and even access to urban kayak rentals.
