Dan's Trail
Oregon



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The trail is open to hiking, biking and horses, and has a packed gravel surface. The trail has three sections, Upper, Middle and Lower. The middle and lower Dan's Trail are flatter trails, while Upper Dan's Trail has many switchbacks and climbs 800ft of elevation.
