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Ernie's Way, a project formed between Ernie Wells and the Gorham Conservation Commission, is a 0.8-mile route that connects the Tannery Brook Preserve to the rest of Gorham.

Portions of the trail are natural-surfaced, while others utilize boardwalks. Please note, cyclists are encouraged to walk their bikes along the boardwalk. Tannery Brook Preserve has several other trails that are open for exploration.
