The West Easton Bike rail is a short rail-trail route that connects trail users to the Tatamy Trail, as well as other trails in the Easton



The West Easton Bike rail is a short rail-trail route that connects trail users to the [Tatamy Trail](#), as well as other trails in the Easton trail network. It is a paved 0.4-mile long route that connects directly to the southern end of the Tatamy Trail and heads north into West Easton along the former Eastern and Northern Branch Rail Corridor.
