Hummingbird Trail

Minnesota



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The family-friendly 7.5-mile Hummingbird Trail is a scenic ride that runs between the charming town of Henderson north to Blakely along the Minnesota River parallel to the Minnesota River Scenic Byway on a pristine asphalt trail. The trail brings scenic natural landscapes, wildlife, especially bird watching (including its namesake hummingbirds) for all to enjoy.

About 7 miles north from Henderson is the Kerfoot Canopy Tour, an adventure park offering other challenges off the trail. The trail reaches its north end at County Rd 5 Faxon Road, just a short road away from the town of Blakely.
