Closure Notice: At the northern end of the trail, there is a small detour between E 51st St. and E 49th St. for new streetcar



A restored streetcar station reminds trail users of the right-of-way past E. 54th Street and Brookside Boulevard. The trail is located in one of the highest-density residential areas of Kansas City and is adjacent to neighborhood commercial and activity centers along its entire length. City parks along the way partially punctuate the urban environment, helping lend a sense of seclusion and offering a place to rest.

The trail has night lighting in limited areas. While most of the route is surfaced with crushed limestone, the section south of E. 85th Street and certain areas prone to flooding are paved. In the north, the trail connects directly to the Brush Creek Trail, which extends east and west along the waterway.

Closure Notice: At the northern end of the trail, there is a small detour between E 51st St. and E 49th St. for new streetcar construction. This closure is expected to last through Spring 2025. Please check with local news authorities for more current information.

The Harry Wiggins Trolley Track Trail, named for the departed state senator who persistently sponsored tax legislation for the Kansas City Area Transportation Authority (KCATA), is one of the most popular trails in Kansas City, Missouri. The trail runs on the former alignment of the city's last streetcar—known as the Country Club route (or Club Line)—which ceased service in 1957.

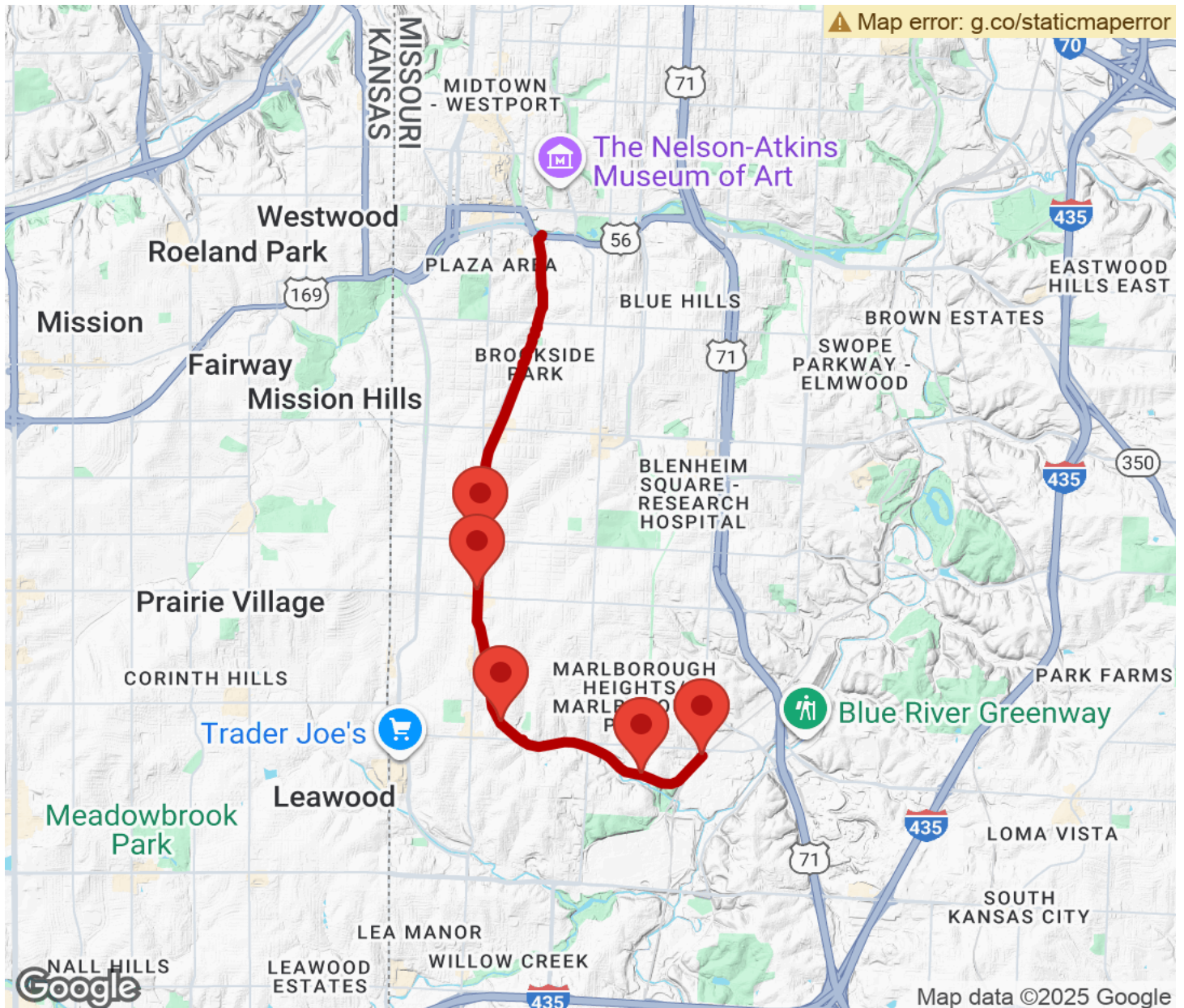
