The White Plains Trail runs for 1.5 miles through White Plains, between JP Hanks Road and just east of town, where enters a thickly



The White Plains Trail runs for 1.5 miles through White Plains, between JP Hanks Road and just east of town, where enters a thickly forested area. The trailhead is a few blocks south of White Plains town center, where you'll also find picnic tables and a monument. From the trailhead, the White Plains Trail heads 0.5 mile west and 1 mile east. West of the trailhead, and to the north, there is a city park with an additional walking trail.

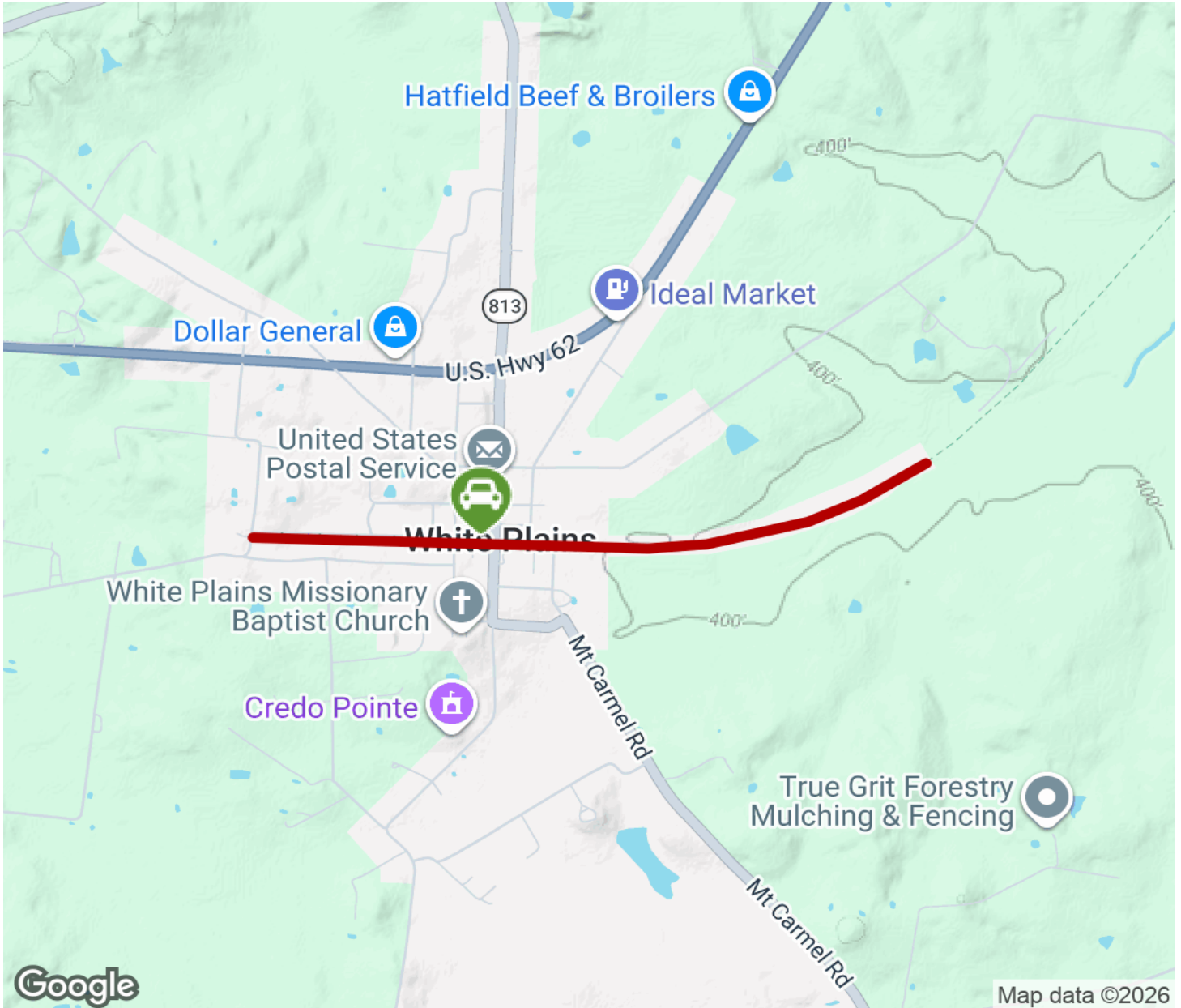
