The trail passes among suburban acreages, along a creek at one point, and past a couple of the town's parks and open spaces, including Florida Refuge. The journey will be slightly downhill as you travel from Prospect Street to Florida Road. The trail was built by Connecticut Light & Power.


The Ridgefield Rail Trail runs between Prospect St. (Ridgefield) and Florida Rd. (Ridgefield).
