## Parking & Trail Access

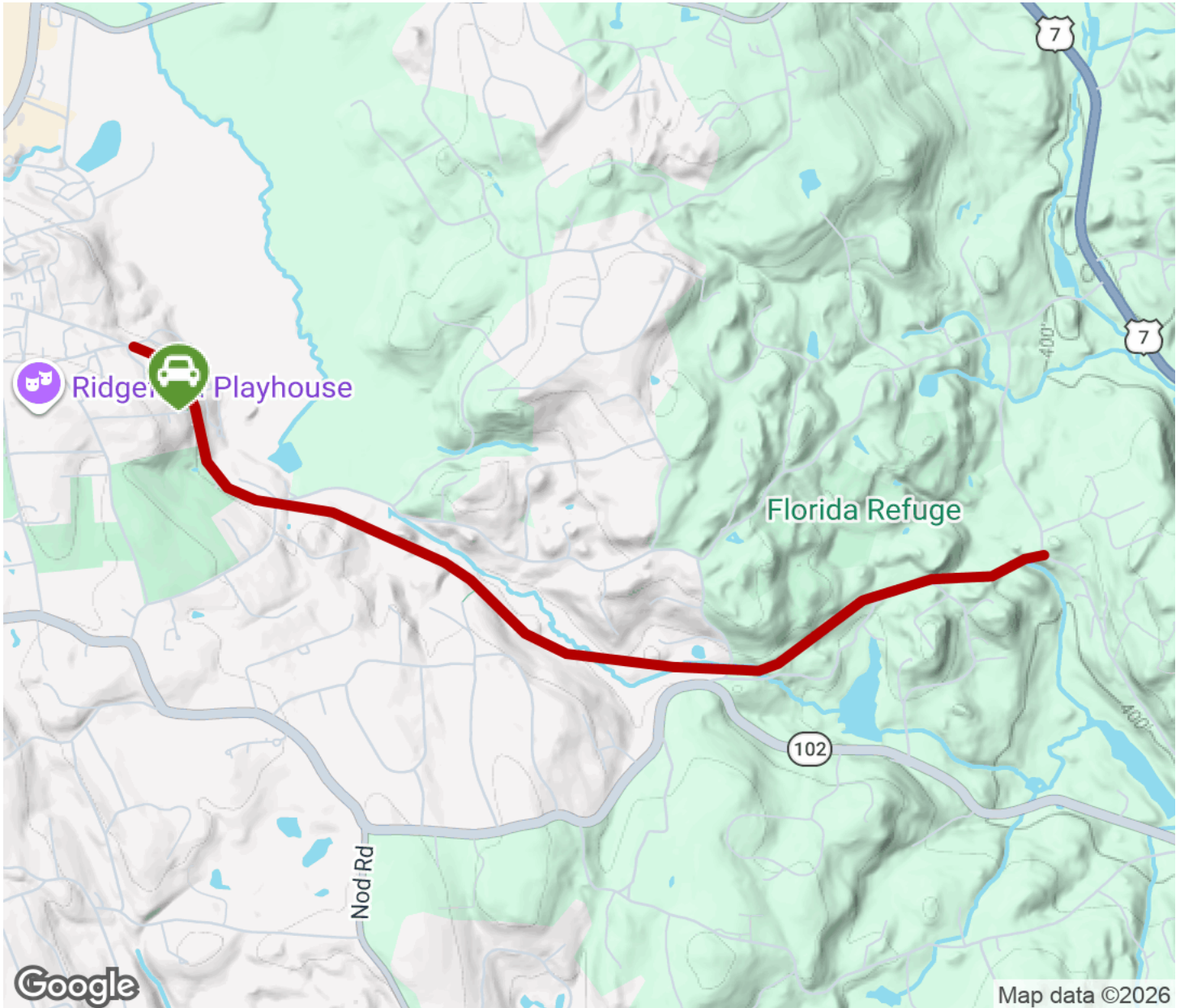
The Ridgefield Rail Trail runs between Prospect St. (Ridgefield) and Florida Rd. (Ridgefield).
