Sumiton Trail

Alabama



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The Sumiton Trail begins at City Hall in the heart of the community of Sumiton, which lies northwest of Birmingham. The mile-long paved trail heads west out of town and ends with a connection to the [Horse Creek Trail](#), which leads to the neighboring community of Dora 3 miles away.

The trail is an important asset to the community, offering easy connections to Bevill State Community College, the local elementary/middle school, the public library, Sumiton Ball Fields, and the downtown area, which all lie just blocks off the trail.

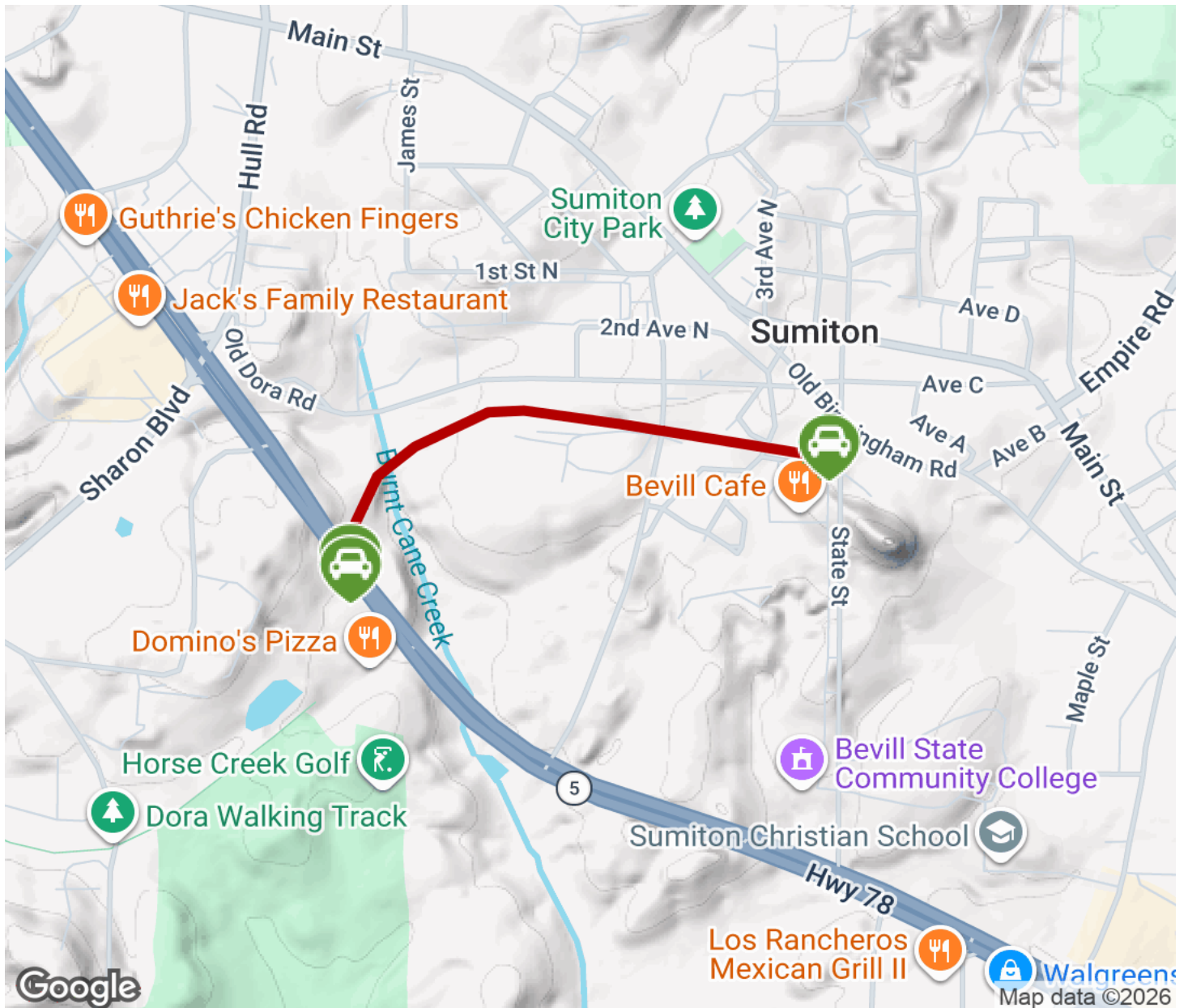
