




Alton Avenue Bike Trail California

The Alton Avenue Bike Trail runs adjacent to both Alton Avenue and an active railroad line through Santa Ana. The path primarily serves the recreational and commuting needs of local residents, including students at Segerstrom High School and Jim Thorpe Fundamental School—both accessible from the western end of the trail.

At the trail's eastern terminus, cross E. Adams Street to pick up the <u>Pacific Electric Bike Trail</u>.

Parking & Trail Access

To access the trail from Interstate 405 in Santa Ana, take the S. Bristol Street exit. Head north for 1.1 miles on S. Bristol Street to Alton Avenue. You can turn right (east) on Alton Avenue and park along the street, or continue west along Alton Avenue to the S. Susan Street endpoint and start there.

Parking for the trail is limited. On-street parking can be found at both the S. Susan Street and S. Orange Avenue endpoints.
