Overview The Clovis Old Town Trail runs for 5.9 miles between N Willow Ave and Clovis Ave. north of E. Shields Ave. in Clovis. The



A highlight along the Clovis Old Town trail is Old Town Clovis itself—the trail’s namesake —just west of the trail, between 4th and 5th Streets. The town lovingly restored the charming town center to hold an early 19th-century appearance, and a historic train depot, relocated from its original home about 1 mile south in Tarpey, occupies a prime downtown site at 4th Street and Clovis Avenue.

Additional highlights along the trail include the Clovis Rodeo Grounds, home to an annual April rodeo since 1914, and Railroad Park on Peach Avenue. The trail is lined with newly planted trees, thanks to a community effort from residents, outdoor enthusiasts, and environmental groups to provide beautiful scenery and shade along the Clovis Old Town Trail. The trail reaches its southern endpoint at Clovis Avenue, just before East Shields Avenue.

Connections

At its northern endpoint, the Clovis Old Town Trail intersects with the [Sugar Pine Trail](#) at N Willow Ave.

The Clovis Old Town Trail intersects with the [Dry Creek Trail \(Clovis\)](#) at N Minnewawa Ave, between Birch Ave and Park Creek Dr.

Overview

The Clovis Old Town Trail runs for 5.9 miles between N Willow Ave and Clovis Ave. north of E. Shields Ave. in Clovis. The paved trail is optimal for joggers, walkers, cyclists and travels through many residential and shopping areas.

About the Route

The Clovis Old Town Trail’s northern endpoint sits at North Willow Ave in a residential neighborhood. As the trail heads south, the route is lined with easy access to residential and commercial areas, shopping centers, and various restaurants.

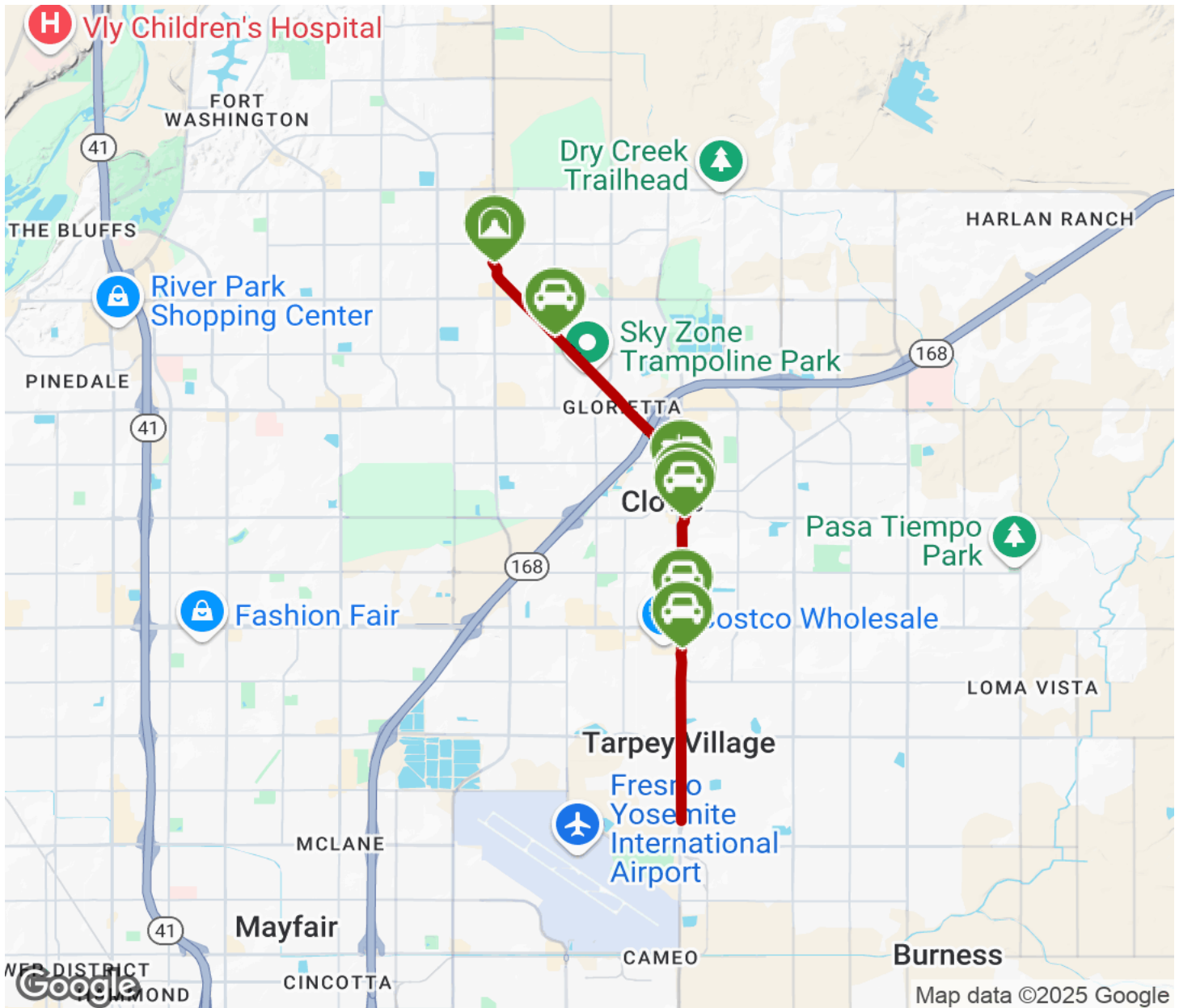
