*The Santa Maria Valley Multi-Purpose Trail runs for more than 2 miles on the southern edge of Santa Barbara County's largest city.*



The Santa Maria Valley Multi-Purpose Trail runs for more than 2 miles on the southern edge of Santa Barbara County's largest city. The northern end occupies a former rail corridor—and parallels an active one—adjacent to the Santa Maria Country Club, while the southern end parallels Skyway Drive and the Orcutt Expressway (State Route 135) next to farmland.

Highlights along the route include the Hagerman Sports Complex, Santa Maria Valley YMCA and Santa Maria Public Airport.

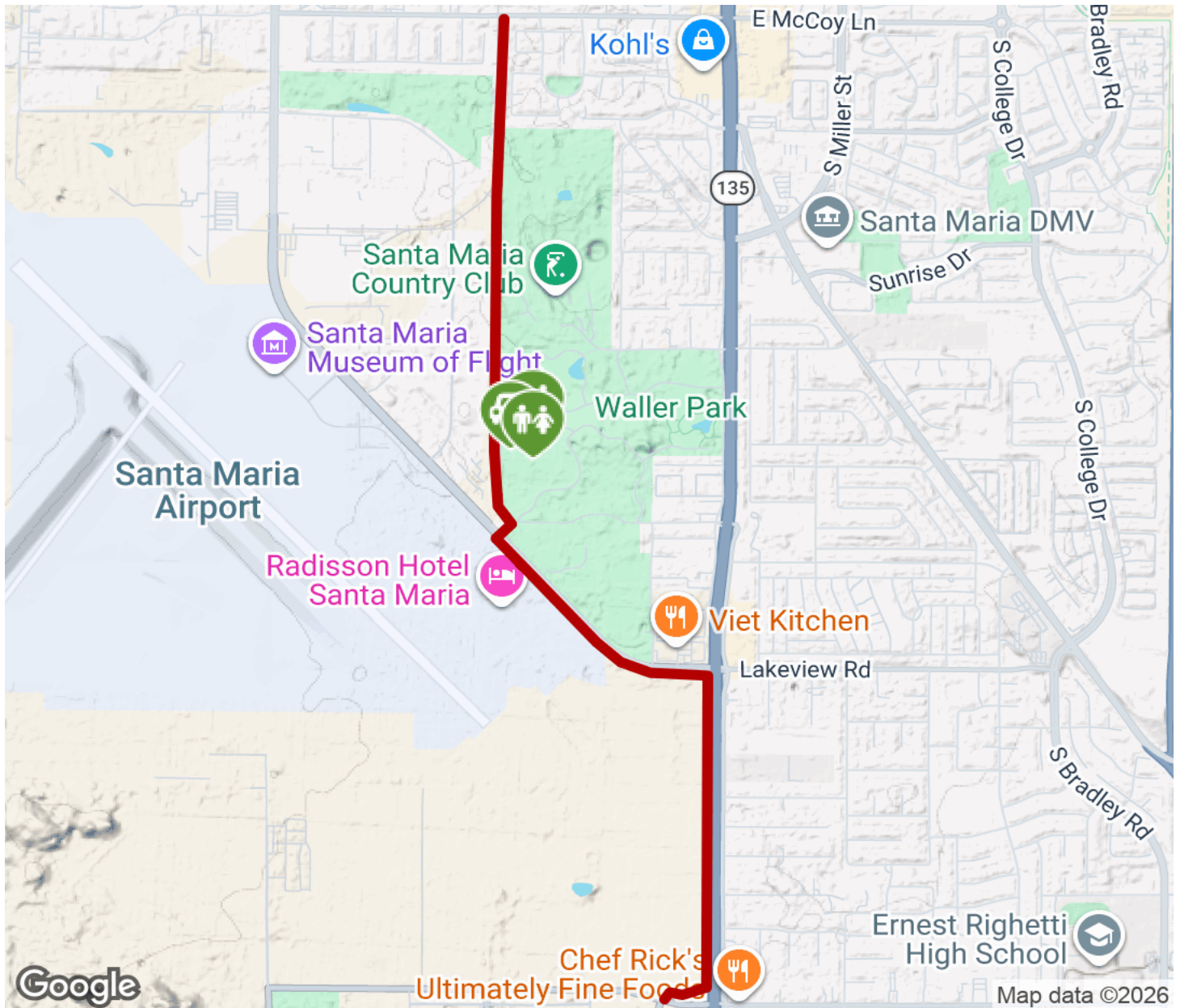
## Parking & Trail Access
