The Southside Bikeway connects downtown Vacaville via a former Sacramento Northern Railway corridor to the city's southern



The Southside Bikeway connects downtown Vacaville via a former Sacramento Northern Railway corridor to the city's southern neighborhoods near Al Patch Park. The route is a nice, short path, ideal for family and neighborhood rides, runs or walks.

Near Eugene Padan Elementary School, the path also intersects the [Alamo Creek Bikeway](#), a scenic trail that runs both east and west along Alamo Creek.

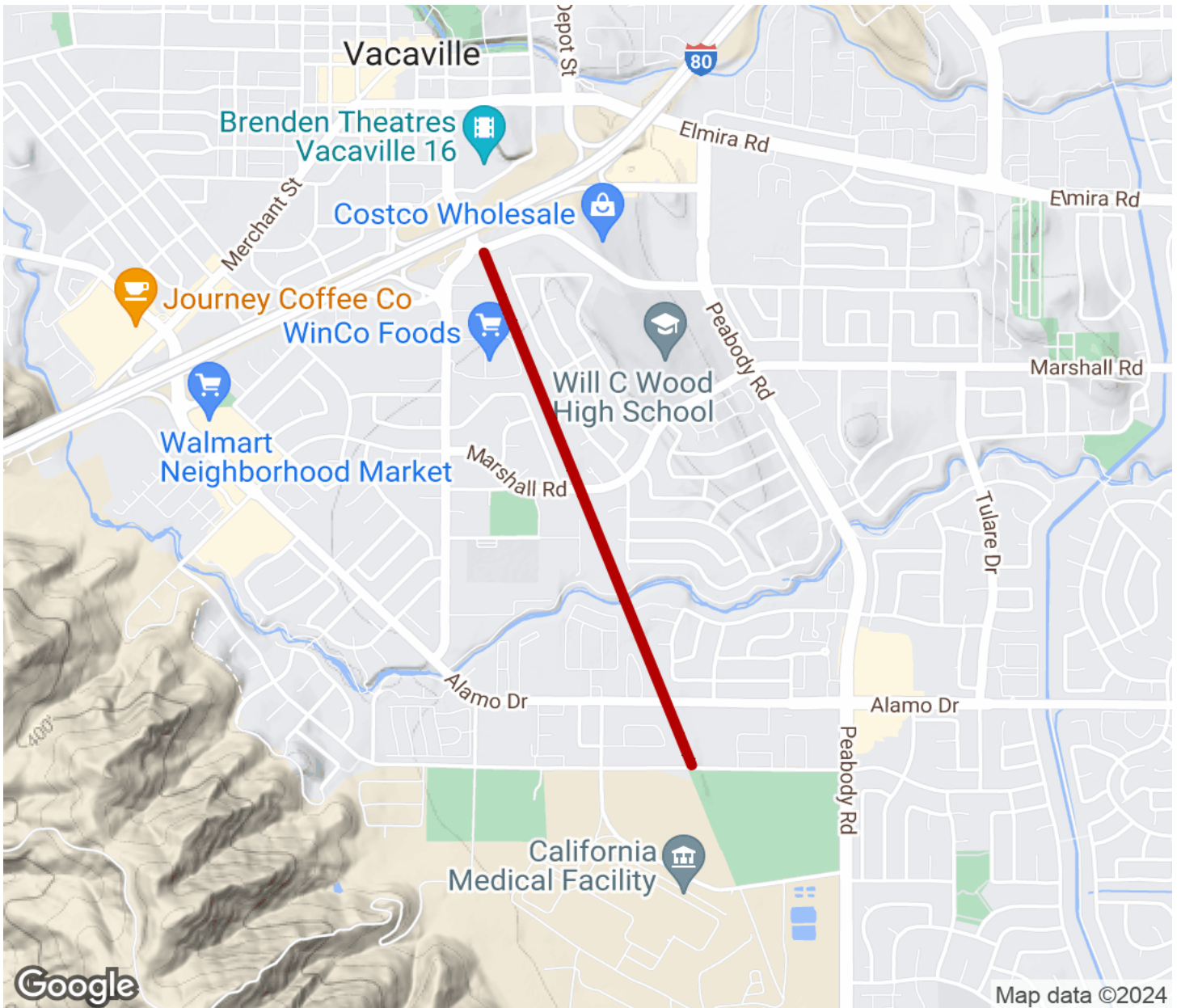
Parking & Trail Access
