### About the Route

The Fraser River Trail offers lovely views of the surrounding mountains and is a great way to connect the two communities without having to ride (or walk) on the road. Along the way you might encounter wildlife, including beavers, moose, deer, coyotes, herons and other bird species. Shuttle buses are available in Winter Park and at Fraser's Safeway. Be sure to stop by the interesting Cozens Museum, which the trail goes right past.

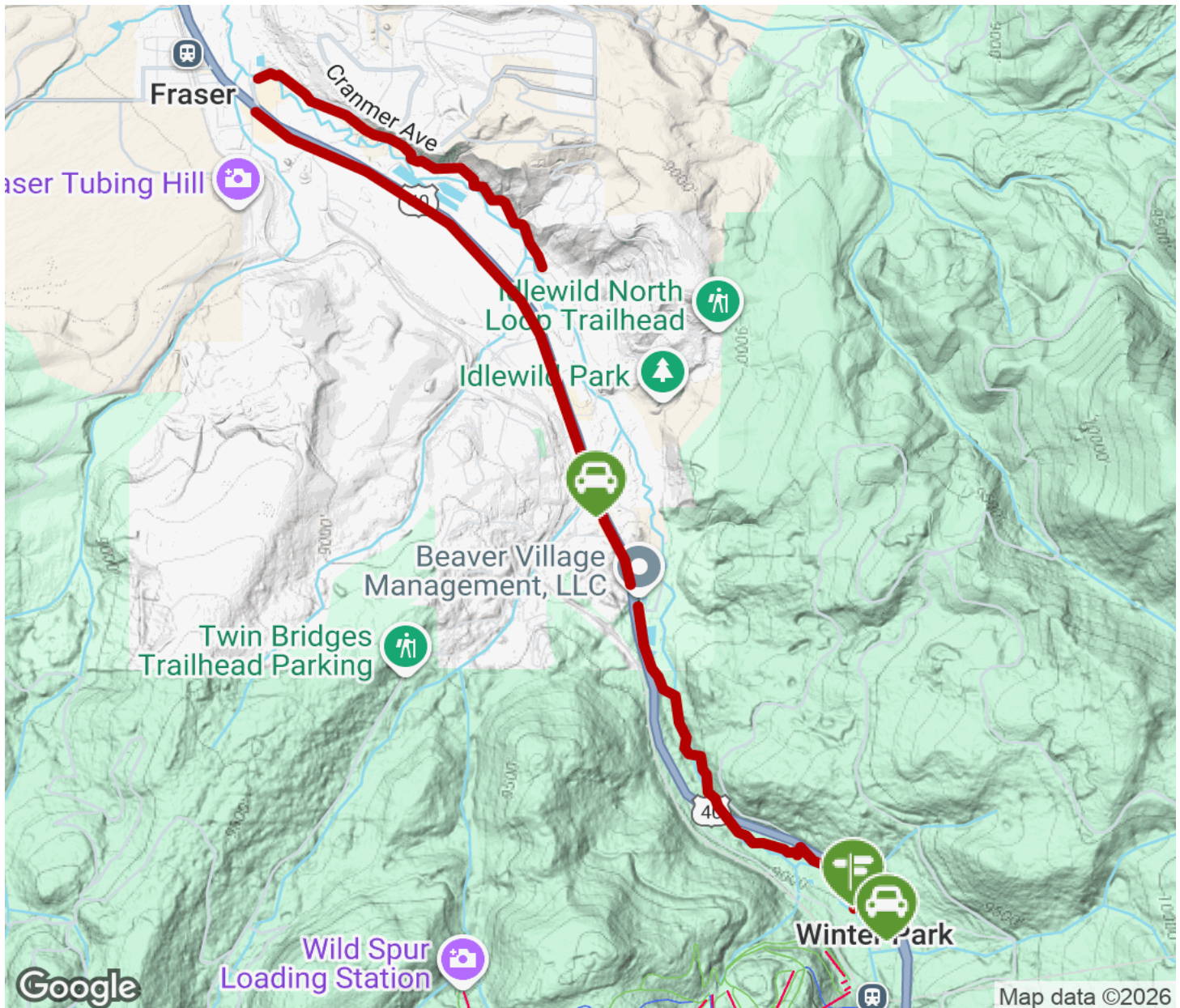
